Governor Dannel P. Malloy signed the following legislation of the 2018 Regular Session on May 29:

- SB 295 AN ACT CONCERNING THE LEGISLATIVE COMMISSIONERS'
PA 18-48 RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING TECHNICAL REVISIONS TO THE PUBLIC
HEALTH STATUTES.
This bill is effective from passage.
- HB 5252 AN ACT CONCERNING REVISIONS TO THE CONNECTICUT ANTITRUST ACT
PA 18-22 AND DISCOVERY CONDUCTED BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL IN WHISTLE-
BLOWER AND FALSE CLAIMS ACTIONS
This bill takes effect October 1, 2018.
- HB 5442 AN ACT CONCERNING THE PARTICIPATION OF NONPROFIT ENTITIES IN
PA 18-27 WORKER COOPERATIVES.
This bill takes effect October 1, 2018
- HB 5579 AN ACT CONCERNING COSTS FOR IGNITION INTERLOCK DEVICE SERVICES
PA 18-30 FOR PERSONS WHO ARE INDIGENT AND ARE SEEKING RESTORATION OF A
MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR'S LICENSE.
This bill takes effect October 1, 2018.
- HB 5515 AN ACT CONCERNING THE AUTHORITY OF A ZONING COMMISSION TO
PA 18-28 REGULATE THE BRIGHTNESS AND ILLUMINATION OF ADVERTISING SIGNS
AND BILLBOARDS.
This bill takes effect July 1, 2018.
- SB 170 AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH AND
PA 18-39 ADDICTION SERVICES' RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING STREAMLINING
REPORTS
This bill takes effect July 1, 2018.
- SB 186 AN ACT CONCERNING SCHOOL COUNSELORS
PA 18-15 This bill takes effect July 1, 2018.

- SB 195 AN ACT CONCERNING CHANGES TO PHARMACY AND DRUG CONTROL
PA 18-16 STATUTES.
This bill takes effect January 1, 2019.
- SB 333 AN ACT CONCERNING MUNICIPAL ELECTRIC UTILITIES AND RATE DESIGN
PA 18-18 STUDIES.
This bill is effective from passage.
- HB 5507 AN ACT CONCERNING THE SOUTH CENTRAL CONNECTICUT REGIONAL
SA 18-4 WATER AUTHORITY.
This bill is effective from passage.
- SB 352 AN ACT EXTENDING THE MORATORIUM ON APPROVAL OF A CERTAIN
PA 18-33 NUMBER OF PROGRAMS OF INDEPENDENT INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER
EDUCATION.
This bill takes July 1, 2018.
- HB 5433 AN ACT CONCERNING MINOR AND TECHNICAL CHANGES TO THE TAX AND
PA 18-26 RELATED STATUTES.
This bill has various effective dates.
- HB 5429 AN ACT CONCERNING INCREASED PENALTIES FOR CERTAIN CIGARETTE
PA 18-25 AND TOBACCO TAX VIOLATIONS, A CONTINUING EDUCATION OPTION FOR
CERTAIN EMBALMERS OR FUNERAL DIRECTORS AND THE IMPOSITION OF
THE TOBACCO PRODUCTS TAX ON CIGARS.
This bill takes effect July 1, 2018.
- SB 150 AN ACT PROVIDING PROTECTIONS FOR CONSUMERS APPLYING FOR
PA 18-38 REVERSE MORTGAGES.
This bill takes effect October 1, 2018.
- HB 5219 AN ACT ALLOWING APPLICANTS FOR SECURITY OFFICER LICENSES TO
PA 18-20 WORK AS SECURITY OFFICERS.
This bill takes effect July 1, 2018.
- HB 5454 AN ACT CONCERNING NINETY-DAY PERMIT TURNAROUND TIMES FOR THE
PA 18-121 DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION.
This bill is effective from passage.

As of this date, the Governor has signed forty-five (45) bills of the 2018 Regular Session.
