Dear Ms. Schmid:

You or your organization has been identified as having solicited or as currently soliciting funds for public or charitable purposes related to the Sandy Hook Elementary School tragedy. Consistent with our duty to oversee fundraising activity in Connecticut, by letter dated March 28, 2013, we asked you to provide information about your organization's fundraising and charitable efforts in support of the tragedy at Sandy Hook Elementary School by completing a brief survey. You have not responded to this survey.


In our ongoing effort to promote transparency and encourage further giving, we again ask you to provide responses to the survey questions. Your voluntary compliance with this request at your earliest convenience will give reassurance to us and to the public that your fundraising activity is compliant with Connecticut law and that all donations are used only for the purposes represented to the public. You should be aware that the Connecticut Solicitation of Charitable Funds Act, Conn. Gen. Stat. § 21a-175 et seq., requires persons or charitable organizations that solicit funds for a public or charitable purpose register with the Connecticut Department of Consumer Protection or file a request for exemption from registration. An organization that solicits funds for charitable purposes without being registered or obtaining an exemption from the registration requirement is subject to penalties under Connecticut law. If you are not registered or have not filed a request for exemption from registration, you must do so immediately. We encourage your voluntary compliance with our request that you provide responses to the enclosed survey and all state registration requirements. 6. Has your organization provided, or does it intend to provide, direct financial assistance to individuals, families or businesses for Sandy Hook relief? If so, what is the approximate dollar amount that your organization has provided to date and approximately how much direct financial assistance does it expect to provide in the future? How does your organization determine the need for assistance?

7. Does your organization have a plan in place on how to use any surplus funds not spent for Sandy Hook tragedy? If so, please describe that plan.
