Governor Dannel P. Malloy signed the following legislation of the 2018 Regular Session on May 31:

- SB 455            AN ACT CONCERNING MINORITY TEACHER RECRUITMENT AND  
PA 18-34            RETENTION.  
This bill has various effective dates.
- SB 142            AN ACT CONCERNING ACCEPTANCE OF INSTITUTIONAL ACCREDITATION  
PA 18-36            OF PRIVATE OCCUPATIONAL SCHOOLS BY THE OFFICE OF HIGHER  
EDUCATION.  
This bill takes effective July 1, 2018.
- SB 194            AN ACT CONCERNING DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER PROTECTION  
PA 18-40            LICENSE STREAMLINING.  
This bill has various effective dates.
- HB 5384           AN ACT CONCERNING PRESCRIPTION DRUG COSTS.  
PA 18-41            This bill takes effect January 1, 2020.
- HB 5574           AN ACT CONCERNING THE FAILURE TO FILE FOR CERTAIN GRAND LIST  
PA 18-42            EXEMPTIONS, VALIDATING A CONNECTICUT GREEN BANK AGREEMENT  
AND CERTAIN ACTIONS OF THE CITY OF DERBY, CONCERNING PAYMENT  
OF A GRANT-IN-AID TO THE TOWN OF DARIEN AND THE CRITERIA OF  
CERTAIN MEMBERS OF SCHOOL GOVERNANCE COUNCILS AND  
EXTENDING A PROVISION CONCERNING REEMPLOYMENT OF CERTAIN  
TEACHERS.  
This bill has various effective dates.
- SB 247            AN ACT CONCERNING PROBATE COURT OPERATIONS  
PA 18-45            This bill has various effective dates.
- SB 260            AN ACT AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL USES OF FUNDS AVAILABLE TO  
PA 18-46            CTNEXT.  
This bill takes effect July 1, 2018.

- SB 284  
PA 18-47 AN ACT CONCERNING BENEFITS FOR CERTAIN VETERANS WHO HAVE BEEN DIAGNOSED WITH POST-TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER OR TRAUMATIC BRAIN INJURY OR WHO HAVE HAD AN EXPERIENCE OF MILITARY SEXUAL TRAUMA.  
This bill takes effect October 1, 2018.
- HB 5542  
PA 18-29 AN ACT CONCERNING BUMP STOCKS AND OTHER MEANS OF ENHANCING THE RATE OF FIRE OF A FIREARM.  
This bill has various effective dates.
- SB 11  
PA 18-49 AN ACT CONCERNING AN AFFECTED BUSINESS ENTITY TAX, VARIOUS PROVISIONS RELATED TO CERTAIN BUSINESS DEDUCTIONS, THE ESTATE AND GIFT TAX IMPOSITION THRESHOLDS, THE TAX TREATMENT OF CERTAIN WAGES AND INCOME AND A STUDY TO IDENTIFY BEST PRACTICES FOR MARKETING THE BENEFITS OF QUALIFIED OPPORTUNITY ZONES.  
This bill has various effective dates.
- SB 184  
PA 18-138 AN ACT CONCERNING AUTHORIZATION OF STATE GRANT COMMITMENTS FOR SCHOOL BUILDING PROJECTS AND CHANGES TO THE STATUTES CONCERNING SCHOOL BUILDING PROJECTS.  
This bill has various effective dates.

As of this date, the Governor has signed fifty-six (56) bills of the 2018 Regular Session.
