

2 of the ~~cultivated~~^{wild} Japs still alive but have not fully recovered from the 1943 severe winter. The trees are planted in a rather exposed location; the Japs not quite as cold resistant as the mollissimas. No signs of blight yet.

15 Aug 1990 no botany dept. now, no chestnut trees extant on campus
