Sept. 1934, Between 200 + 300 trees of various kinds growing in 2 plantings. Generally bear good crop. Trees apparently neglected. Trees about 50 yrs old. No blight. Trees injured by freeze fall 1932

Nuts picked up from the ground under a large tree in the yard. Mr. Suttlemeier has a large old planting of 100-200 trees that have now gone more or less wild. The area is now used for a horse pasture. Mr. Suttlemeier was not at home but I learned from other sources that the trees generally bear well. Other chestnuts occur nearby in an uncultivated mixture of hardwoods. I will attempt to see Mr. S. sometime.
