

St. Luke's Chapel, Stamford

The SHPO awarded Hurricane Sandy disaster relief funds to Inspirica, Inc. for the rehabilitation of St. Luke's Chapel (a.k.a. the Chapel of St. Luke the Physician) in Stamford's South End. The project included masonry repairs, window repairs, and the replacement of cedar siding and roofing, wood trim, and exterior doors.

St. Luke's Chapel is a portion of a complex operated by Inspirica, a nonprofit organization that provides temporary and transitional housing, as well as a range of other services, to the homeless in Fairfield County. The Romanesque Revival/Shingle Style building, with cedar roof and siding shingles and a native stone base, was built in 1891. It is individually listed in the National Register of Historic Places for its architectural significance.
