

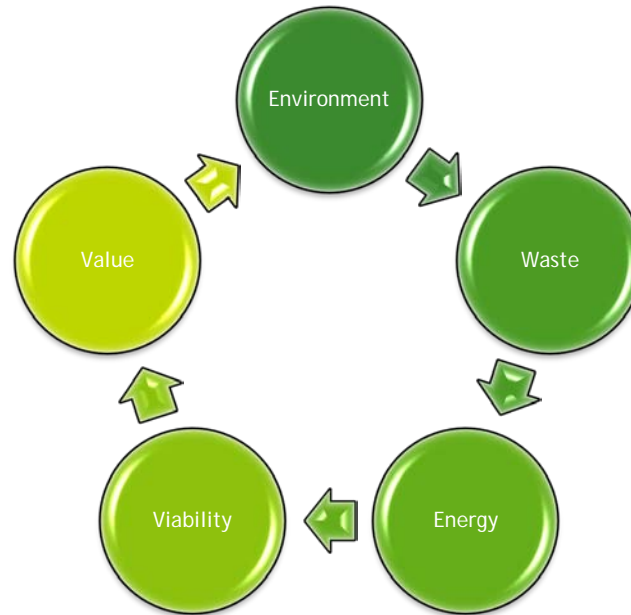

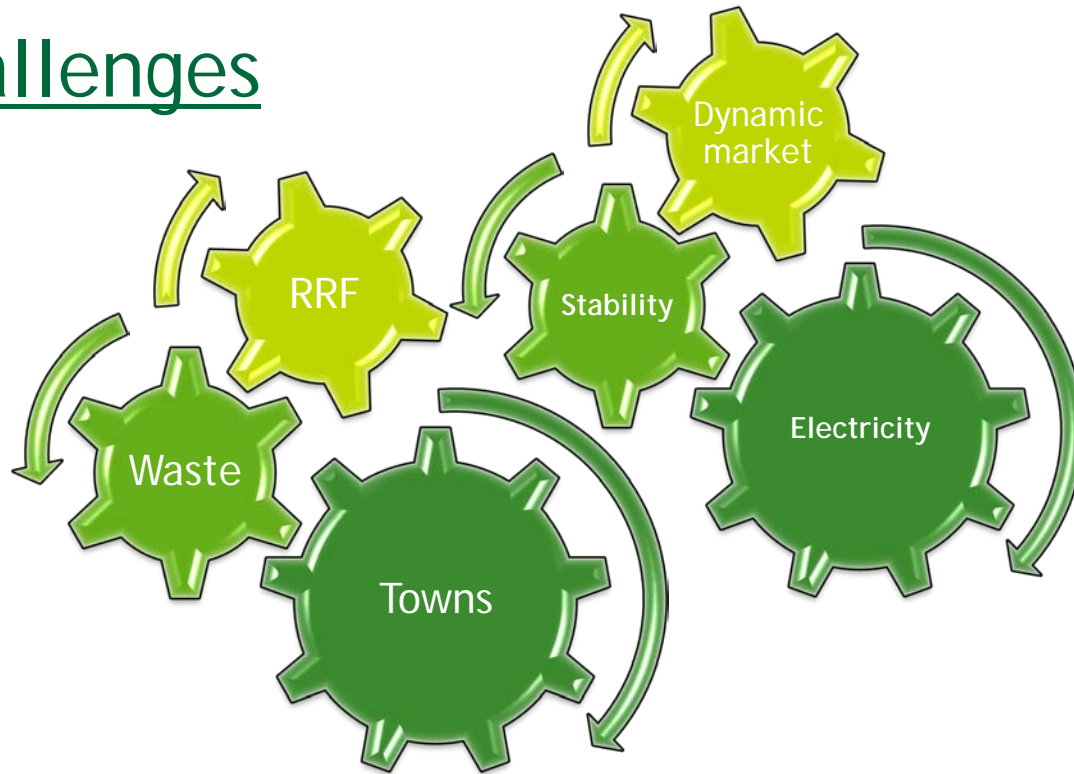


Concept



- Communities will dispose of their municipal solid waste in an environmentally responsible manner and receive power directly from the Resource Recovery Facility.
- Communities and the RRF's would benefit by stable budgets. The energy and municipal solid waste would be tied to a contract term of XX years.

Challenges



- Require a licensed partner to manage power daily- minimize risk & ensure stability in an ever changing power market.
- On peak/off peak demand - usage changes as towns start/stop Ops
- Cover demand positions when plant outages occur.
- RRF's are a "Must Run" facility regardless of market price.

Opportunities



- Identify any methods to remove fees charged to Retail Power Providers. Legislative opportunities
- Energy Improvement Districts (EID). Pass on savings to business
- Competitive pricing above wholesale market
 - eg: Utility to carry RRF generating capacity in its portfolio @ XX\$/MW
- Standardize RRF industry tax evaluations or implement PILOT payments.
