

As the Customers' participation is in the interests of justice and will not impair the orderly conduct of this proceeding, the Customers are hereby **GRANTED** limited intervenor status. As a limited intervenor, the Customers will not be permitted to conduct cross-examination or to raise objections to any evidence except when its own witness is being cross-examined. The Customers will be permitted to conduct re-direct, and to make opening and closing arguments.
