The contract between Christian Community Action, Inc. ("Contractor") and the Connecticut Department of Social Services ("Department"), which was last executed by the parties and approved by the Office of the Attorney General on 12/1/2014, and previously amended on 7/21/2015 is hereby further amended as follows:

- 1. The term of the contract is extended for an additional one (1) year and the end date of the contract is changed from 6/30/17 to 6/30/18.
- 2. The total maximum amount payable under the contract has increased by \$120,000 from \$402,639 to \$522,639 to provide funding for the extended term of the contract.

b. Add

\$120,000 from SID 16160 for FY 2018
