In the [Public Safety and Security Committee](#) the following bills will be heard on March 10, 2020:

[SB-408](#) (RAISED) AN ACT CONCERNING USE OF OPIOID ANTAGONISTS AND CARTRIDGE INJECTORS BY POLICE OFFICERS.

[SB-428](#) (RAISED) AN ACT CONCERNING ASSISTED OUTPATIENT TREATMENT FOR CERTAIN PERSONS WITH PSYCHIATRIC DISABILITIES.

[HB-5449](#) (RAISED) AN ACT REQUIRING EXPANSION OF THE CRISIS INITIATIVE PILOT PROGRAM THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

[HB-5450](#) (RAISED) AN ACT CONCERNING EMERGENCY INTERVENTION BY A POLICE OFFICER WHEN A PERSON SUFFERS AN OPIOID OVERDOSE.
