Call to Order

Commissioner Reviczky called the meeting to order at 2:02 p.m.

Big E Schedule

Commissioner Reviczky welcomed attendees and explained there was one item to discuss. He asked Rebecca Murphy to provide overview of the efforts to fill the schedule for the Big E Wine booth in the Connecticut Building, and presented two draft schedules, both with vacancies. A discussion ensued. Jonathan Edwards offered to fill several open days instead of exhibiting on September 19. A motion was made by Jim Frey to accept the Option B schedule modified with Jonathan Edwards Winery filling from September 24 through September 28 instead of September 19 and authorizing DoAg to fill September 19 with a willing winery. The motion was seconded by Jonathan Edwards and passed unanimously.

The Council discussed ideas for ensuing years, including formation of a cooperative to address scheduling challenges of filling the wine booth.

DoAg will assist exhibitors in preparing the required documents which need to be returned ASAP to DoAg to meet deadlines of the West Springfield Liquor Commission.
