



The above captioned matter was heard as a contested case on September 27, 1976, at which time the complainant and the respondents appeared and entered on the record a stipulation withdrawing the complaint.

Pursuant to the stipulation of the parties, it is recommended that the Commission find the following facts:


1. On August 14, 1976, the respondent board held a regularly scheduled meeting.
2. A record of the votes taken at, and the minutes of, the respondents meeting of August 14, 1976 were not available for public inspection within the time requirements prescribed by §6 of P.A. 75-342.
3. The complaint has been withdrawn on the assurance of the respondents that henceforth the respondents will conduct their activities in strict conformance with P.A. 75-342.
4. It is recommended that, subject to the foregoing finding, this complaint be dismissed.
