NOTICE OF DECISION NOT TO SCHEDULE HEARING

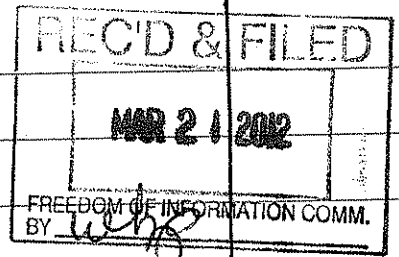
#### 4. REMEDIES
