POST COUNCIL FIREARMS QUALIFICATION RELAYS

B-60CT target. A minimum of 80% must be fired to qualify. This is a 300-point relay so a score of 240 is the minimum score that can be fired. All hits, to count, must be in the CM-5 area and are 5 points each.

Qualifying Relays:

25 YDS	Barricade: Kneeling window 6 rounds, standing weak side 4 rounds, standing strong side 6 rounds ALL STRONG HAND FIRING.	1:45 sec	16 rds
15 YDS	Strong hand standing 6 rounds, then kneel and fire 4 rounds, combat reload, scan, holster and stand up preparing for next sequence (re-supply sources etc.)	:45 sec	10 rds
12 YDS	Strong hand standing 6 rounds, then kneel and fire 4 rounds, repeat above.	:45 sec	10 rds
7 YDS	Strong hand standing 6 rounds, then switch weapon to weak hand fire <u>4 rounds weak hand only</u> repeat combat reload, scan, holster and re-supply if necessary.	:45 sec	10 rds
4 YDS	Strong hand standing 6 rounds, then kneel and fire 4 rounds, repeat above procedure.	:45 sec	10 rds
2 YDS	Block and Hip position, fire 4 rounds.	:08 sec	4 rds

Clear weapons, check and make line SAFE.
