Subject: 2019-20 Out-of-Town Magnet Transportation Grant

Dear Superintendents,

The 2019-20 Out-of-Town Magnet School Transportation Grant Application (Form ED021) is now open for the fall submission. The purpose of Form ED021 is to collect information necessary to calculate grants for out-of-town magnet school transportation under Section 10-264i of the Connecticut General Statutes. The grant will be paid in two installments: the first in October 2019 equal to one-half of the estimated grant, and the balance in May 2020 based on revised data from the spring submission of Form ED021 (which will be due March 16, 2020).

Form ED021 and instructions are located on the Connecticut State Department of Education (CSDE) data collection Web site at <https://www.csde.state.ct.us>. **Districts applying for the grant must complete data entry and enter the Superintendent's certification code by September 16, 2019.** Districts not applying for the grant are not required to complete or certify the application.

In order for a student and associated transportation costs to be included on this application, both of the following conditions must apply:

1. The student must be transported to and from an approved interdistrict magnet school not located in the student's local school district.
2. The student's local school district must register or maintain a record of the student.

Please refer to the instructions for examples and important details concerning the number of students and costs to be reported on this application.
