FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

A special education hearing in the above-captioned matter was requested by Student's Parents via Request for Impartial Special Education Hearing dated August 12, 2010.¹ The thirty-day resolution period runs through September 11 and the deadline for mailing the final decision and order is October 26, 2010.

The Request for Hearing raises the following issue: Was the Board of Education's action in removing Student from the afterschool and summer program appropriate?

The undersigned Hearing Officer was appointed on August 18. On August 18, before a pre-hearing conference could be scheduled, Student's Parents wrote to the Hearing Officer and indicated that they reached an agreement with the Board of Education and that they are not pursuing due process.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

In light of the above facts, the above-captioned case is hereby dismissed.
