FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Whether the Board knew or should have known that the Student was a student with a disability before the occurrence of the behavior that precipitated the pending disciplinary action in accordance with 34 CFR §300.534.
2. Whether the Board shall conduct an expedited evaluation of the Student.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/DISCUSSION:

This expedited request for hearing was received by the Board on November 16, 2010. A prehearing conference convened on November 29, 2010. On December 9, 2010, prior to the first hearing date, the Parent's attorney submitted notification that the parties had entered into a stipulation after the resolution meeting and were no longer pursuing this hearing.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED**.
