**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

**ISSUE:**

Whether the Board's evaluations of the Student are appropriate.

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY/DISCUSSION:**

This request for hearing was submitted by the Board on November 23, 2011 and a prehearing conference convened on December 2, 2011. At the prehearing conference, the Board's attorney confirmed that the Parents had withdrawn their request for an IEE at this time.
