FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Whether the Board failed to offer a free, appropriate public education (FAPE) to the Student for the 2010-2011 school year;
2. Whether the Board failed to offer FAPE to the Student for the 2011-2012 school year.

SUMMARY:

On February 2, 2012, the Board received the Request for Due Process. On February 10, 2012, a Prehearing Conference was held and hearing dates were scheduled. On February 16, 2012, the Parent withdrew the Request for Due Process without prejudice.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice.
