FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUE:

Should the Student have an intellectual evaluation?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY:

The Board of Education requested a special education due process hearing in the above-captioned matter on December 20, 2016. This Impartial Hearing Officer was appointed to hear the case on December 22, 2016. A telephonic pre-hearing conference was scheduled for January 12, 2017.


On January 12, 2017, the Board of Education requested that the matter be dismissed.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

It is ordered that the Student's request is granted and the matter is dismissed.

If the local or regional board of education or the unified school district responsible for providing special education for the student requiring special education does not take action on the findings or prescription of the hearing officer within fifteen days after receipt thereof, the State Board of Education shall take appropriate action to enforce the findings or prescription of the hearing officer.

Appeals from the hearing decision of the hearing officer may be made to state or federal court by either party in accordance with the provisions of Section 4-183, Connecticut General Statutes, and Title 20, United States Code 1415(i)(2)(A).
