**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

**ISSUES:**

The following issues have been identified for determination at the hearing:

1. Did the Milford Board of Education offer the Student a program for the start of the 2019/2020 School Year?
2. If not, is the Student entitled to compensatory education services?

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:**

The Student initiated this special education due process case on October 11, 2019. This Impartial Hearing Officer was assigned to the case on October 16, 2019. A Notice of Prehearing Conference was issued on October 21, 2019 for a conference on October 28, 2019.

On October 21, 2019, the Student reported that the matter had been resolved and requested that the case be withdrawn or dismissed.
