PRESCRIBED FORM FOR RETURN OF VOTES CAST AT A MUNICIPAL ELECTION
(C.G.S. §9-314(b))

The moderator shall make a preliminary list of the votes cast at such municipal election, as reported solely by the tabulator and shall immediately transmit such preliminary list to the Secretary of the State not later than midnight on election day. Once the preliminary list has been transmitted, the moderator shall make a duplicate list of the votes given for each municipal office elected. The moderator shall transmit such duplicate list to the Secretary of the State by electronic means not later than forty-eight hours after the close of the polls on election day. The moderator shall also seal and deliver one of such duplicate lists to the Secretary of the State not later than the third day after the election. The moderator shall also deliver one of such duplicate lists to the clerk of such town. Use additional pages if necessary.
