Welcome to the State of Connecticut's Online Voter Registration System

To use the online voter registration system you must have a current and valid driver's license, learner's permit or non-driver photo identification card issued by CT Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) with signature on file with DMV.

You may use this system to (1) register to vote in Connecticut, (2) change your name and/or address on your current registration record, or (3) enroll in a political party or change party enrollment (changing parties may result in losing rights in all parties for three months).

If you move you must re-register to vote in your new town of residence. You can also use this form to change your address if you move within your current town of residence.

If you have questions please contact your local Registrar of Voters or the Secretary of the State.

Registration Instructions:

1. Fill in all of the required fields on this application;
2. You are not a voter until your application is approved by the Registrar of Voters;
3. You should receive a confirmation within three weeks. If you do not, contact the Registrar of Voters in your town;

NOTE: The particular social service office at which you register to vote, or whether you decline to register, remains confidential and will be used only for voter registration purposes.

REGISTRATION DEADLINES FOR NEW VOTERS :

PRIMARY: Your application must be submitted by the 5th day before a primary (OR received by your Registrar of Voters or a voter registration agency by the 5th day before a primary). You may apply in person to your town clerk or registrar until 12:00 noon on the last business day before a primary.

ELECTION: Your application must be submitted or received by a voter registration agency by the 14th day before an election (OR you may register in person with your Registrar of Voters by the 7th day before an election)

As you are aware, we will soon launch a new Online Voter Registration System that will allow an applicant to register to vote online. The applicant must have a current and valid DMV record in order to use the Online Voter Registration System. Provided the applicant qualifies to use the new system, they will complete the application using the system and the completed application will be sent to you for review. The completed applications will show up in the reminders section of CVRS in two different categories (1) DMV online applications and (2) applications to be received by mail.

- (1) DMV online applications are those submitted completely electronically from applicants that have an existing DMV record. This application will have a corresponding electronic signature. You will be able to review the application, make changes to the record, pull an existing record from another town and print a hard copy of the application from the system. Once you accept the application, the voter will be added to the CVRS system and treated like any other voter. A letter of acceptance will print for the voter just like any ordinary voter you enter into the system.
- (2) Those applicants who do not have an existing DMV record can also use the system to produce a paper registration application that they must sign (as we cannot access their electronic signature) and send to you through the US Mail. The benefit is that the application, once received by you, will have a code on the top. You can enter this code to pull up the application and all of the information from that application will be pre-filled on CVRS. You will be able to review the application, make changes to the record and pull an existing record from another town. Once you accept the application, the voter will be added to the CVRS system and treated like any other voter. A letter of acceptance will print for the voter just like any ordinary voter you enter into the system.

In an effort to better assist you with this new process, we have added some numbered screen prints to this message and we will discuss these in greater detail below:

Screen 1 – This shows the reminders screen with the added detail of the online voter registration applications.

Screen 2 – This shows the registrars summary screen of those applications submitted electronically because the applicant had an existing DMV record. This screen allows you to print a list of the applicants, search for a record (if necessary), and view the details of any selected record.

Screen 3 – This shows the voter registration detail of an electronic application submitted. This screen allows you to review the details of the application, select the voter as either NEW or pull the voter from another town, review the voter's signature and print a hard copy of the voter registration card.

Screen 4 – This shows the search screen for those voters who submitted an application to you by US Mail. This voter was able to use the system to produce a voter card but was not able to use the system to electronically submit their application because they did not have an existing DMV record. From this screen you would enter the "Reference ID" (recommended) or other information such as last name and hit search. The system will return the voter record corresponding to that search.

Screen 5 – This shows the search results returned depending on the search criteria used. From this list you will be able to choose the voter who matches the voter registration card received by you in the US Mail.

Screen 6 – This shows the voter registration screen in CVRS. As you can see, once the voter is selected all of the information on the screen is pre-populated. You can review this information, make a change if necessary and ultimately accept the voter.

Screen 7 – This shows the voter confirmation page that you would see after you process any voter. This page allows you to print the letter of acceptance for the voter.

Screen 8 – This shows the letter of acceptance that the system will produce once the voter is accepted and entered into the CVRS system. From here, the voter will be treated like any other voter. They can be moved to inactive, their party or address can be changed, etc.




