Subject: CERTIFICATION OF SECURITY BY INDIVIDUAL INSURANCE
COMPANIES

As required under section 38a-372, every insurance company authorized to transact the business of private passenger motor vehicle liability insurance in the State of Connecticut shall file an approved form with the Commissioner of Insurance declaring that its policies provide the security required by Conn. Gen. Stat. §38a-371.

The approved certification form must be signed by an officer of the company. Your submission of the completed form to the Insurance Department will be your acknowledgment of receipt of this letter.
