I make the following statement, without fear, threat or promise. I have been advised that any statement(s) made herein which I do not believe to be true, and which statement is intended to mislead a public servant in the performance of his / her official function, is a crime under C.G.S. section 53a-157b and is punishable by law. JD

On the night of 05/09/17 I was in my assigned car, Unit B17, on the C-shift. Myself along with Officer M. Blackwell and Officer A. Gianpaolo were on a residential alarm cal on Norman St in my assigned sector. We had already deemed my call a false alarm. Shortly after at approximately 1701 hours we all hear over channel one Det Borrico of the Gang Unit stating that he was following a stolen motor vehicle. We then quickly entered our vehicles with lights and sirens proceeded towards the area of Park Ave near Laurel Ave. As I was traveling south on Park Ave, still behind Officer Blackwell, I heard over channel one that there were shots fired. I then followed Officer Blackwell's vehicle into the Walgreens parking lot (1000 Park Ave) from the Washington Ave entrance at which point another unknown marked squad car cut in front of me. I then proceeded toward the Walgreens exit on the Fairfield Ave side near the Walgreens entrance where I slowed down and observed Det Borrico exiting from the driver's side door of a blue Chevy S-10 type pickup. Said Chevy S-10 was parked on the exit ramp just before Fairfield Ave. At this point I drove on the right of the S-10 pickup and parked my patrol car on Fairfield Ave facing east. I then exited my vehicle and observed Officer Pecirep who was ordering the passenger in the stolen vehicle to exit said vehicle. I then observed the passenger door of said vehicle open at which point myself and Officer Pecirep guided the passenger out of the vehicle and onto the ground. I then observed bloodpooling on the back of the passenger's shirt and advised Officers on scene to be aware of the blood. As Pecirep and other Officers on scene placed passenger in custody I immediately requested medics over channel one.

At this point Det Borrico was walking with Officer Boulay towards my patrol car and Det Borrico asked who's car that was, at which I responded it was mine. Det Borrico then advised me to transport Officer Boulay to Bridgeport hospital immediately however I advised them that we are to always to go to St Vincent's hospital. Sgt Cuccaro then advised me to transport Officer Boulay to St Vincent's hospital. I then transported Officer Boulay to St Vincent's hospital with lights & siren. I observed Officer Boulay breathing rapidly with strong breaths almost as if he was hyperventilating. I then patted Officer Boulay on his shoulder and told him to just relax and breathe. I also went over channel 2 and advised CAD to advise St Vincent's ER staff that we were in route. Upon arrival at the hospital the ER staff was waiting for us in the ambulance bay. We then parked and exited my vehicle at which point Officer Boulay was placed in a wheel chair and taken into an ER room. In hospital I took custody of Officer Boulay's duty belt with ever item on it including his dept issued firearm along with his secondary firearm, dept issued taser, his clothing, shoes, vest carrier with ballistic panels, all of which were in my possession until I drove back to original scene at Fairfield Ave & Park Ave where I transferred all of Officer Boulay's property over to Detective Frank Mugavin of the Western District Major Crime Squad of the CT State Police at approximately 2005 hours. Detective Mugavin took my information then release me from the scene. Sgt Lynch was with me in the hospital as well as on scene with Detective Mugavin.
