Interview Report: Civilian Witness #3

On 05/23/2017 at approximately 1430 hours, I met with [redacted] to obtain a written statement regarding the events he had witnessed on 05/09/2017 at approximately 1700 hours as he was driving on Fairfield Avenue in Bridgeport, CT. Between 1455 and 1615 hours I obtained a 3-page written statement from [redacted] which included the following.

[redacted] is [redacted] who had stopped his Hyundai Sonata (CT Plate: [redacted]) in the right lane of Fairfield Avenue when he saw the Subaru stopped in the Walgreens exit driveway approximately sixty feet in front of him. As [redacted] watched, the marked Bridgeport Police cruiser pulled up behind the Subaru and both doors of the police car opened. The cruiser's passenger (Ofc. Boulay) immediately ran around his car door and up to the passenger side of the Subaru as the operator (Jayson Negrón) pulled the Subaru forward. [redacted] described the Subaru as lurching forward a few inches, stopping for a matter of seconds, then lurching forward again out onto Fairfield Avenue attempting to travel northbound against traffic. Other vehicles began moving to avoid the Subaru, and [redacted] pulled his vehicle forward partially onto the sidewalk of Fairfield Avenue. [redacted] described the Subaru as being "wedged in between 2 oncoming vehicles" and not being able to move. [redacted] described that one officer was standing at the driver's door of the Subaru (Ofc. Boulay) and one was standing at the passenger door (Ofc. Pecirep). Both officers had their guns drawn and pointed towards the

vehicle. reported the officer on the passenger side yelling, "Get out of the fucking car or I'm gonna fucking shoot you!" indicated he was paying more attention to the officer on the passenger side "when it came to talking." saw the driver's side officer (Ofc. Boulay) open the driver's door as the passenger side officer was yelling for the occupants to get out of the car. Neither occupant complied with instructions. remembered noticing that the occupants did not have their hands raised. At a time when attention was directed towards a vehicle to his left which was backing out of the area, grazing the driver's side of his Hyundai, he reported hearing the first gunshot. stated, "After hearing the first shot, I looked back over at the Subaru and I saw the D/S officer standing next to the Subaru. The driver's door remained open and I remember being able to see the officer was partially behind the driver's door. I don't remember noticing if the car was moving or stationary. I hear and saw the D/S officer fire four (4) more shots into the Subaru within approximately two (2) seconds. The P/S officer did not shoot." He looked back over at the Subaru and saw the driver's side officer (Ofc. Boulay) standing behind the open driver's door while firing into the vehicle. could not state whether the Subaru was moving or stationary at this time. reported, "I remember hearing one of the people I the Subaru say something like, 'You shot me, dude. Really?' I heard the driver (Negrón) say, 'I think you got my heart.'" stated one of the officers called on his radio for paramedics to respond immediately after the shots were fired. could not specify how the driver got out of the vehicle but he remembered seeing him lying motionless on the ground face-down in handcuffs. At this point, indicated he began seeking a way to leave the scene. He was eventually cleared to leave by an unknown Bridgeport Police officer.
