ACTION TAKEN:

On May 9, 2017 at approximately 1705 hours, Paramedic, Andrew Levino #1219 and his partner Advanced EMT, Kevin Handel #1264, were dispatched to an officer-involved shooting located at 1000 Park Avenue Bridgeport, CT. Mr. Levino is currently a certified Advanced EMT and on the evening of May 9th, he was working in his official capacity for American Medical Response (AMR). Mr. Handel provided medical attention to an individual ultimately identified as \_\_\_\_\_, date of birth; \_\_\_\_\_.

On the above-mentioned date, I conducted an interview with (AMR) American Medical response Advanced EMT Handel. Introductions were made and the purpose of the interview was conveyed. At which time,

Handel voluntarily attested to the following verbal and sworn written statement:

Kevin Handel is a (28) twenty-eight year old male currently certified as a (AEMT) Advanced Emergency Medical Technician and has been employed by (AMR) Advanced Medical Response for approximately (6) six years. Mr. Handel is currently working as a full time employee and relayed that he has responded to multiple medical calls involving the discharge of a firearm and has triaged those individuals who have sustained such related injuries.

On May 9, 2017 Mr. Handel was assigned to truck #7111 which was designated as a (ALS) Advanced Life Support Unit with his partner, Paramedic Andrew Levino #1219. At the time of dispatch they were posted in the Town of Fairfield with Mr. Handel operating the vehicle. Mr. Handel relayed that his unit was dispatched Priority (1) one (meaning), lights and siren at approximately 1705 hours, to the area of 1000 Park Avenue, Bridgeport CT, (Walgreens Pharmacy). Upon their arrival Mr. Handel relayed that the Bridgeport Police Department was already on-scene and appeared to have had the area secured with yellow tape. The scene Supervisor, Paramedic Robert Calzone #709 was also on-scene attending to the wounded. Handel relayed that based on his medical certification and the nature of the call he was assisting Paramedic, Levino who would have been the primary care-giver. Handel relayed when he exited the ambulance he grabbed the stretcher from the rear of the ambulance along with the gear required to provide medical treatment. Handel and his partner Levino were directed by Supervisor, Calzone to render medical aid to the patient who was later identified as \_\_\_\_\_, date of birth; \_\_\_\_\_. Handel relayed that once the patient \_\_\_\_\_ was stable they moved him into the ambulance where he was ultimately transported priority (1) to Bridgeport Hospital for injuries he sustained during an officer-involved shooting (SEE ATTACHED WRITTEN REPORT).

**\*\*\*NOTE:** Handel was given the option of writing out his own statement or having me reduce it to written form. Handel opted to write his own statement. Upon completion, Handel carefully reviewed the document for accuracy and content. Handel indicated the entire statement was true to the best of his knowledge and belief. At which point, I administered the oath and Handel signed the one (1) page statement.
