ACTION TAKEN:

On May 9th, 2017 at approximately 1705 hours, Paramedic, Andrew Levino #1219 and his partner EMT, Kevin Handel #1264, were dispatched to an officer-involved shooting located at 1000 Park Avenue Bridgeport, CT. Mr. Levino is currently a certified Paramedic and on the night of May 9th, he was working in official capacity for American Medical Response (AMR). Mr Levino provided medical attention to an ultimately identified as date of birth;

On the above-mentioned date, I conducted an interview with (AMR) American Medical response Paramedic,

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Andrew Levino. Introductions were made and the purpose of the interview was conveyed. At which time, Levino voluntarily provided a verbal and subsequent typed written statement.

"05/09/2017- Initial dispatch priority 1 (lights,sirens) received at 1705hrs at intersection of I95SB exit ramp N Benson Rd in Fairfield. I95NB to exit 27 to 1000 Park Ave for incident. Arrival at scene 1711hrs. On a 21 year old male was found lying handcuffed in the prone position on Fairfield Avenue with penetrating wound noted to left scapula/upper back and a left bicep/tricep entry/exit wound. Bullet casings noted on around patient and care was taken to not disturb evidence. GCS 15. Moderate bleeding from wound in back, controlled with direct pressure. Handcuffs removed by (unknown) Bridgeport Police officer and patient was restrained with arms in front of body before rolling patient onto back in order to protect spine. C-collar Rapid trauma exam performed in which another wound was noted left mid-scapular superior to the nipple line. Lung sounds clear and equal bilaterally and patient described no shortness of breath.

Patient moved to stretcher via sheet while protecting spine with manual stabilization. Vital signs noted in patient care report. 18ga IV in right antecubital. Normal 3 lead EKG. Left wrist abrasion (scratches) noted on secondary exam. Patient calm and cooperative en route to Bridgeport Hospital. SWCMED- P2 trauma alert transport to hospital. AMR-P1 transport. BPD officer in patient compartment en route.

On arrival to Bridgeport Hospital care transferred to staff in trauma room. Patient remained stable throughout transfer."

Upon completion, Levino carefully reviewed the document for accuracy and content. Levino indicated the entire statement was true to the best of his knowledge and belief. At which point, I administered the oath and Levino signed the one (1) page statement.
