INTERVIEW REPORT: Passenger of the Subaru

On 05/09/2017 at approximately 2020 hours, Detective Chris Allegro and I conducted a verbal interview with _____ in the Emergency Department of Bridgeport Hospital (267 Grant Street, Bridgeport CT), where _____ had been transported by American Medical Response ambulance for treatment of the gunshot wounds he suffered during the Use of Force incident at 1000 Fairfield Avenue.

The purposes of the interview were to identify the (then) unknown vehicle operator – subsequently identified as Jayson Negron – and to gather general facts which led up to _____ presence at the scene.

The interview was recorded using an Olympus VN-5200PC Digital Voice Recorder. The interview recording (27min 12 sec in duration) was entered into evidence as Exhibit #0111 in this case – refer to separate Exhibit Report for that item.

Upon entering the hospital room, we observed _____ seated in a stretcher, with his right arm secured to the gurney by a pair of handcuffs installed by Bridgeport Police, who were detaining _____ until the details of the stolen vehicle in which he had been a passenger were worked out.

Following the interview, provided his written consent for detectives to obtain his medical records pursuant to his treatment for his injuries sustained in the Use of Force incident – see attached Consent to Search form.

Additionally, Detective Allegro photographed in order to document his injuries – refer to Detective Allegro's separate Photo Report.
