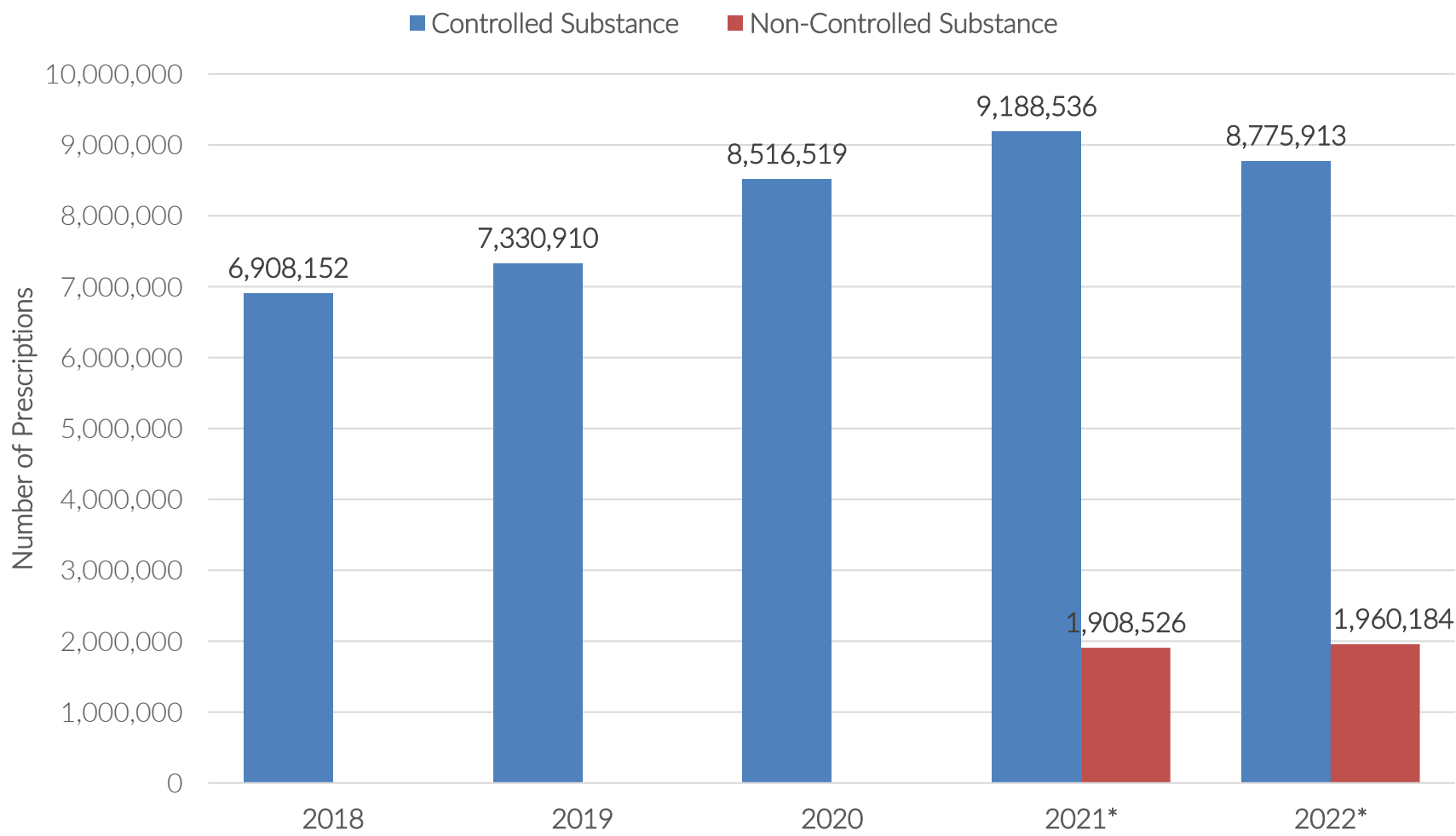

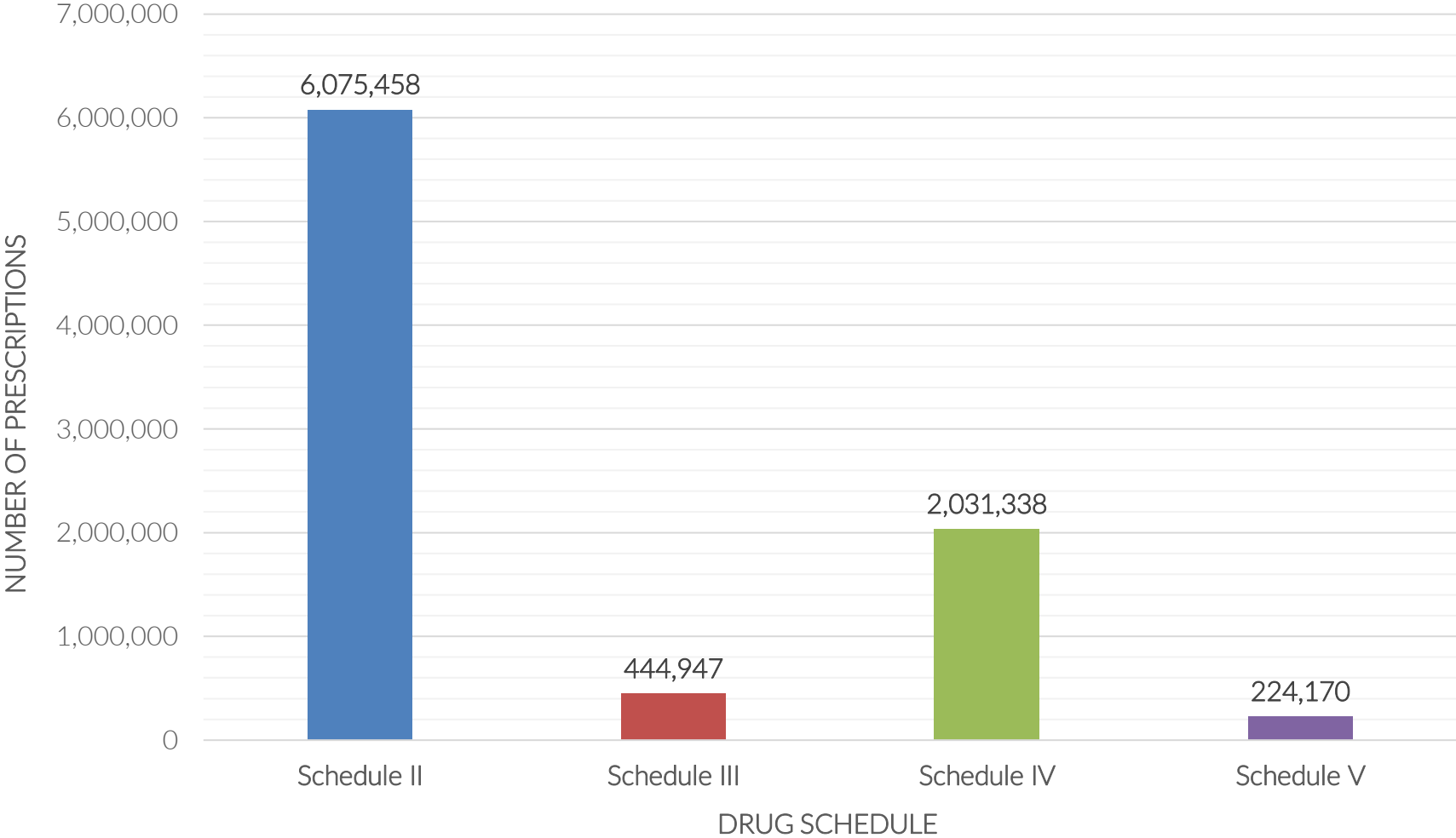
Prescriptions Dispensed



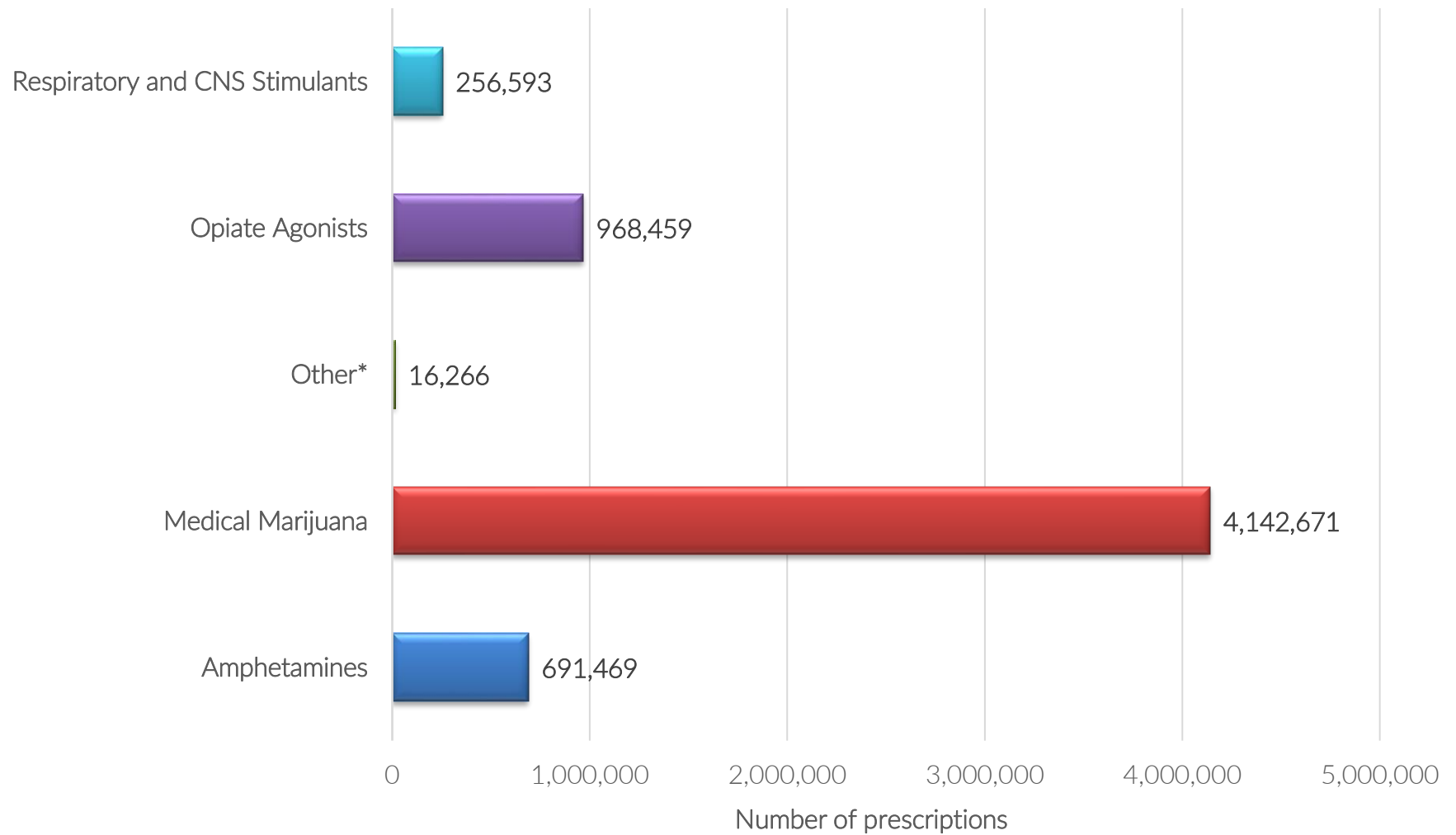

2022 Prescriptions by Drug Schedule



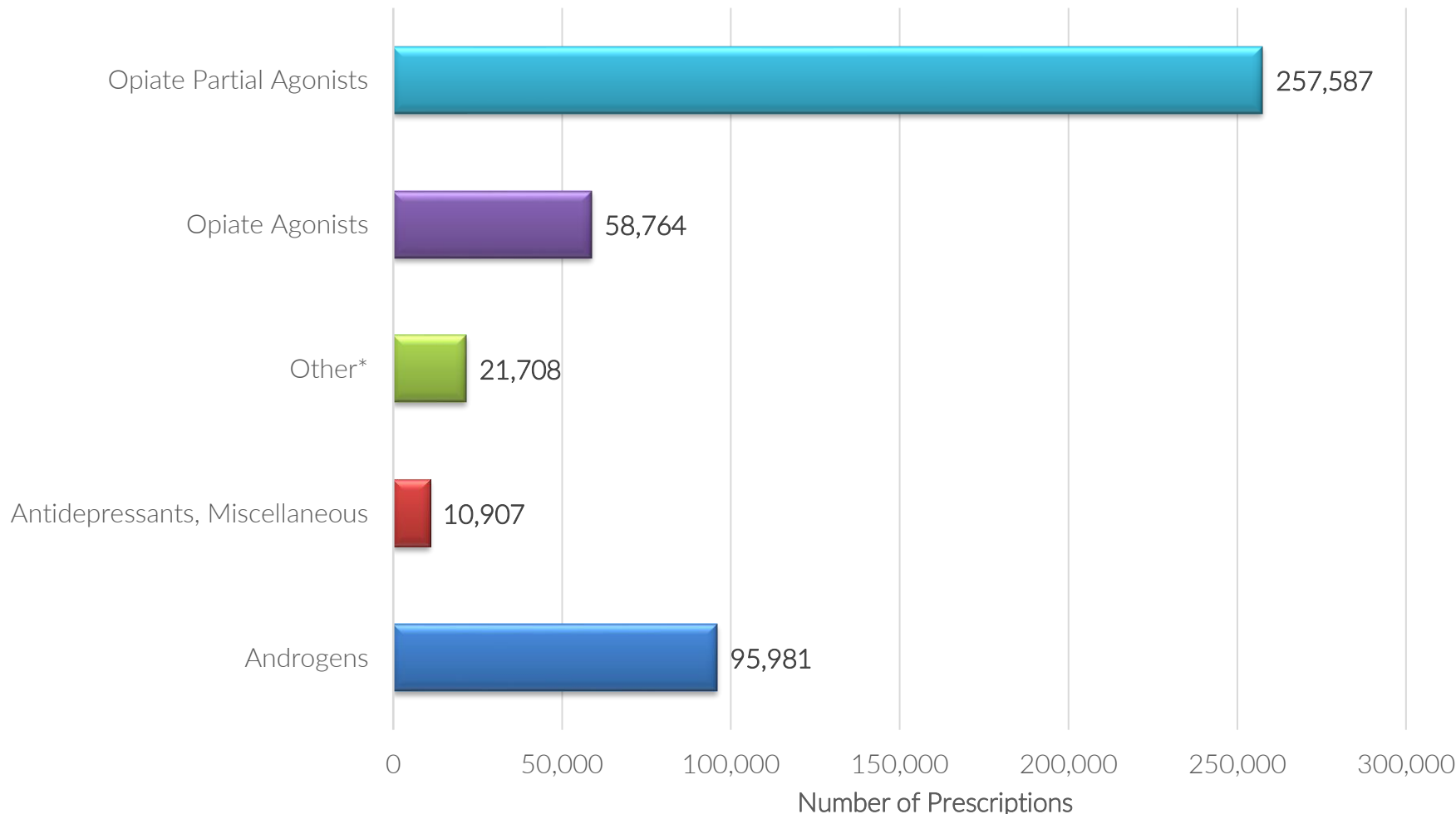
2022 Schedule II Prescriptions by Drug Class

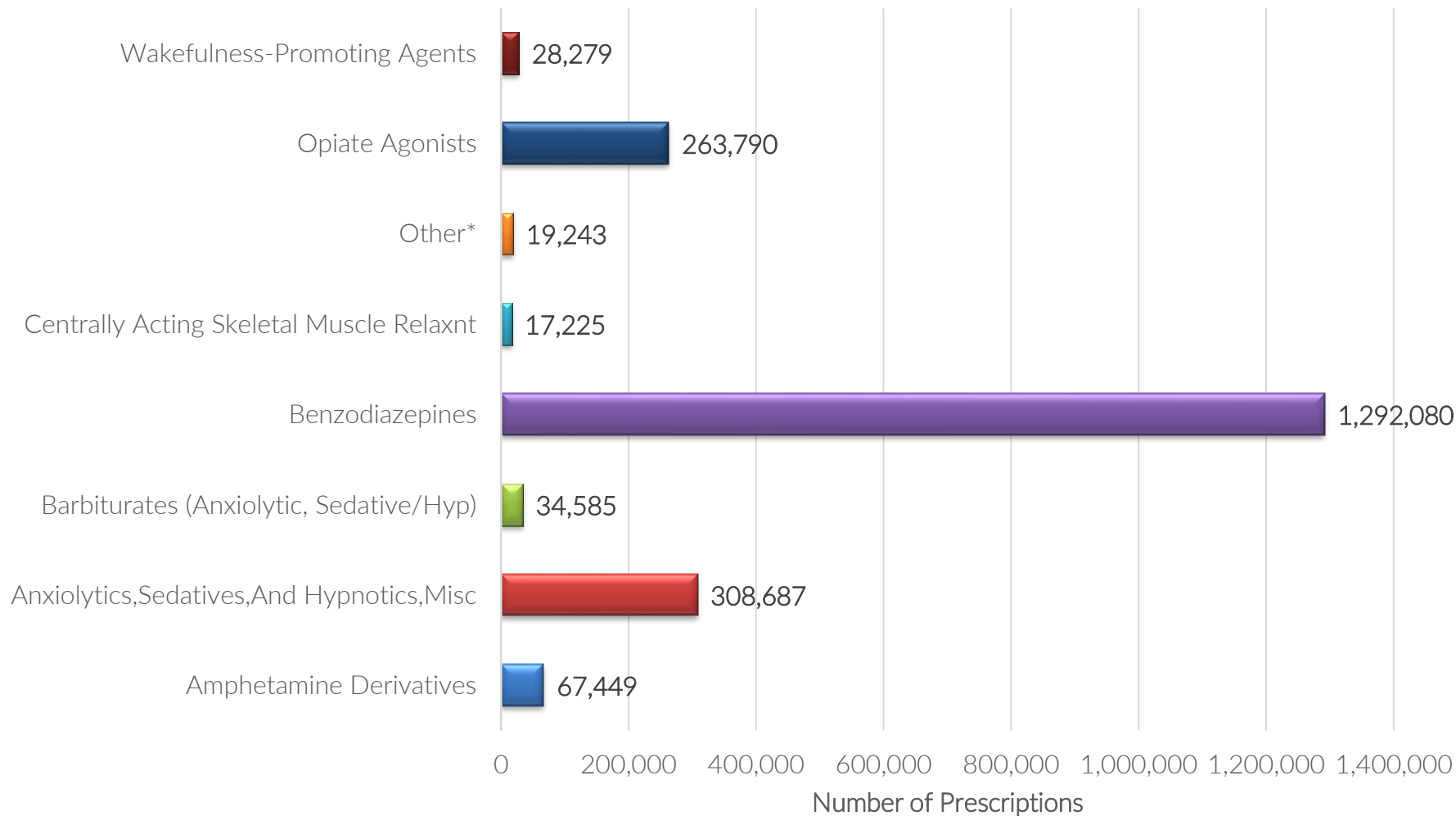
2022 Schedule III Prescriptions by Drug Class

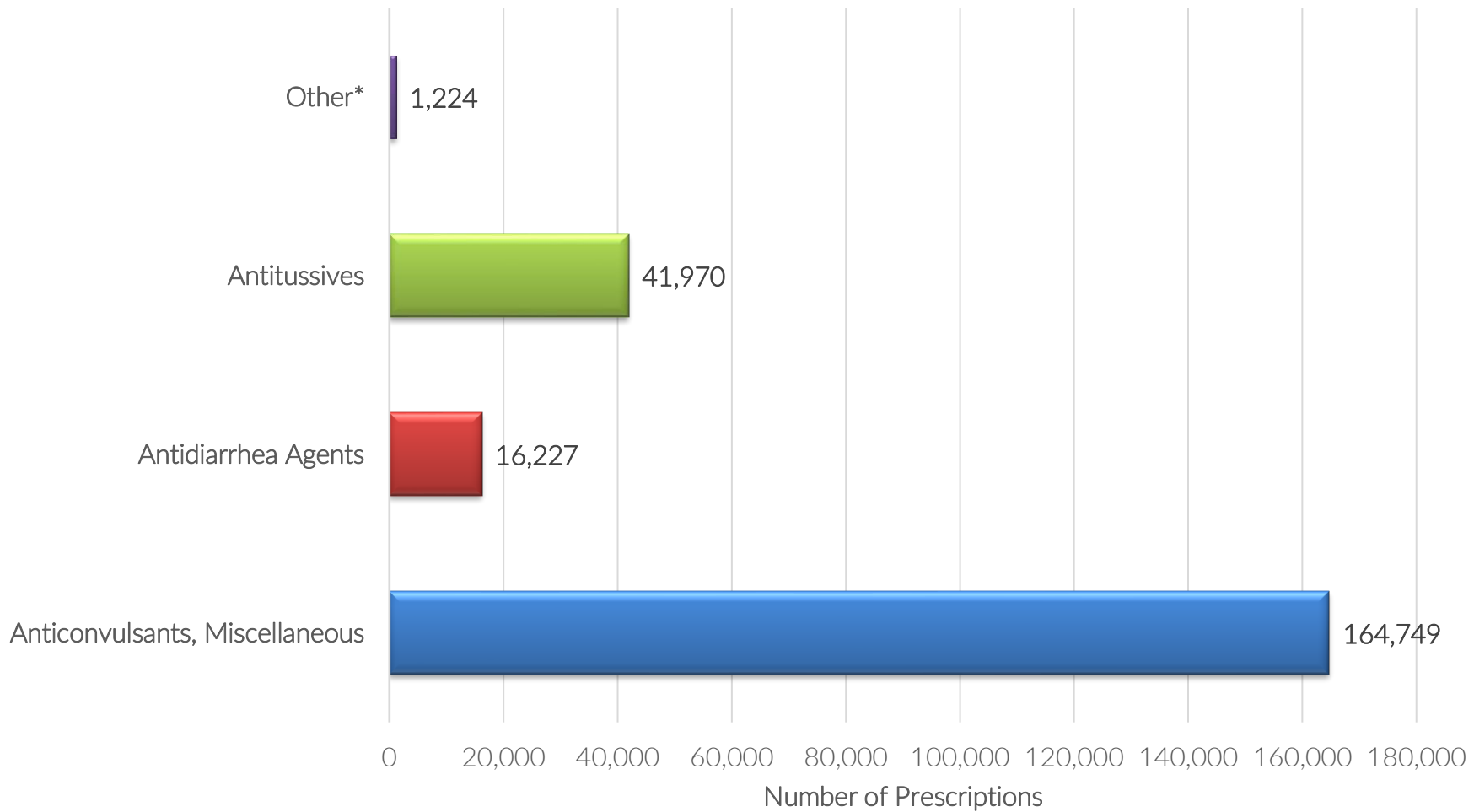
2022 Schedule IV Prescriptions by Drug Class

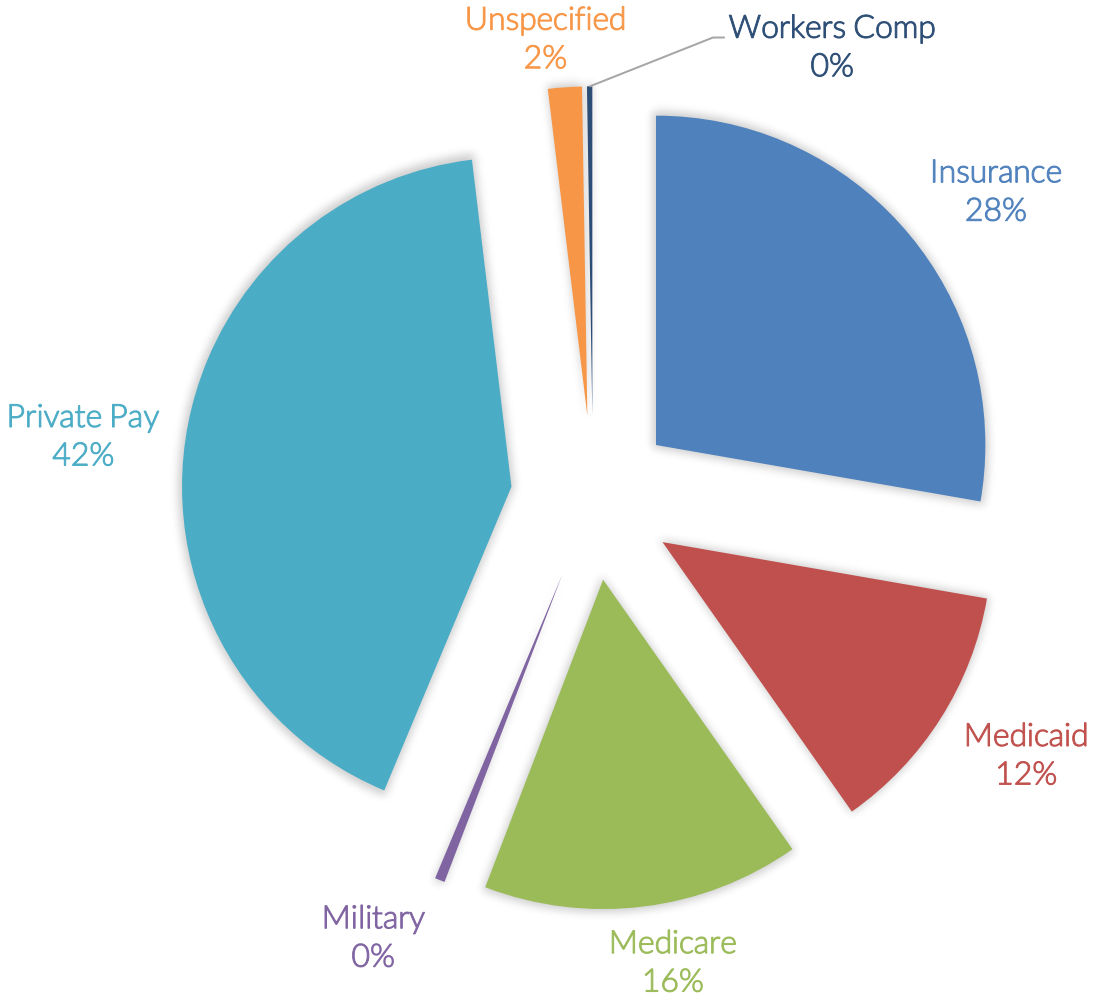
2022 Schedule V Prescriptions by Drug Class



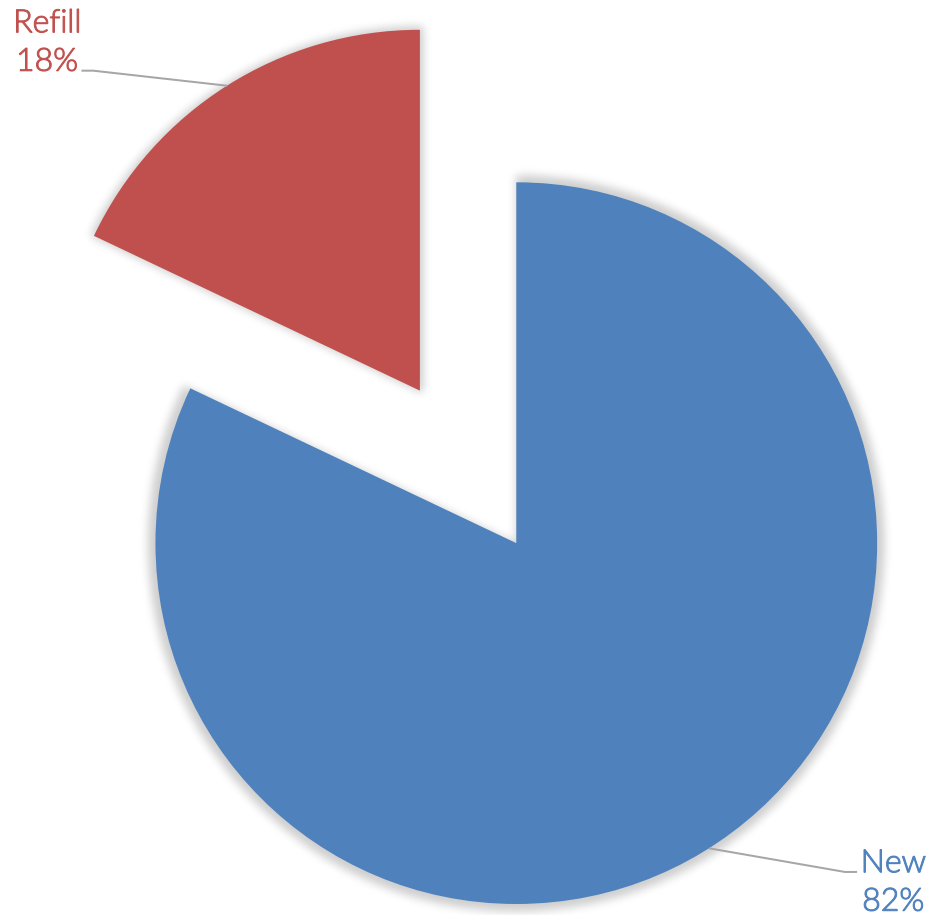

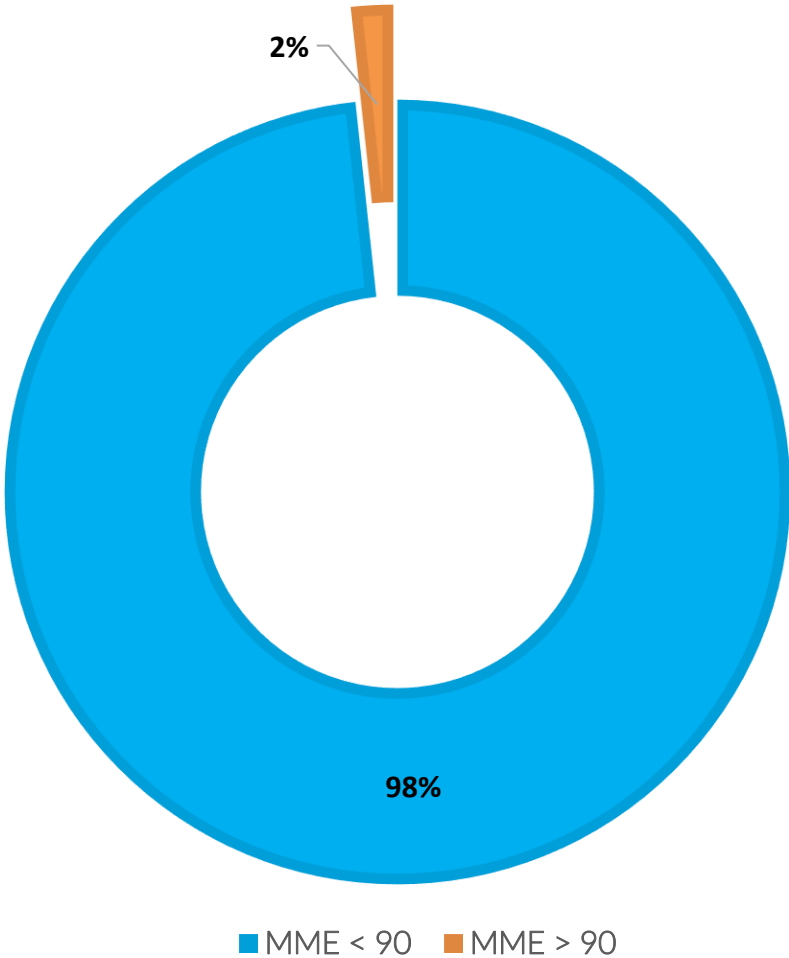
2022 Payment Type of Prescriptions



2022 New vs. Refill of Prescriptions



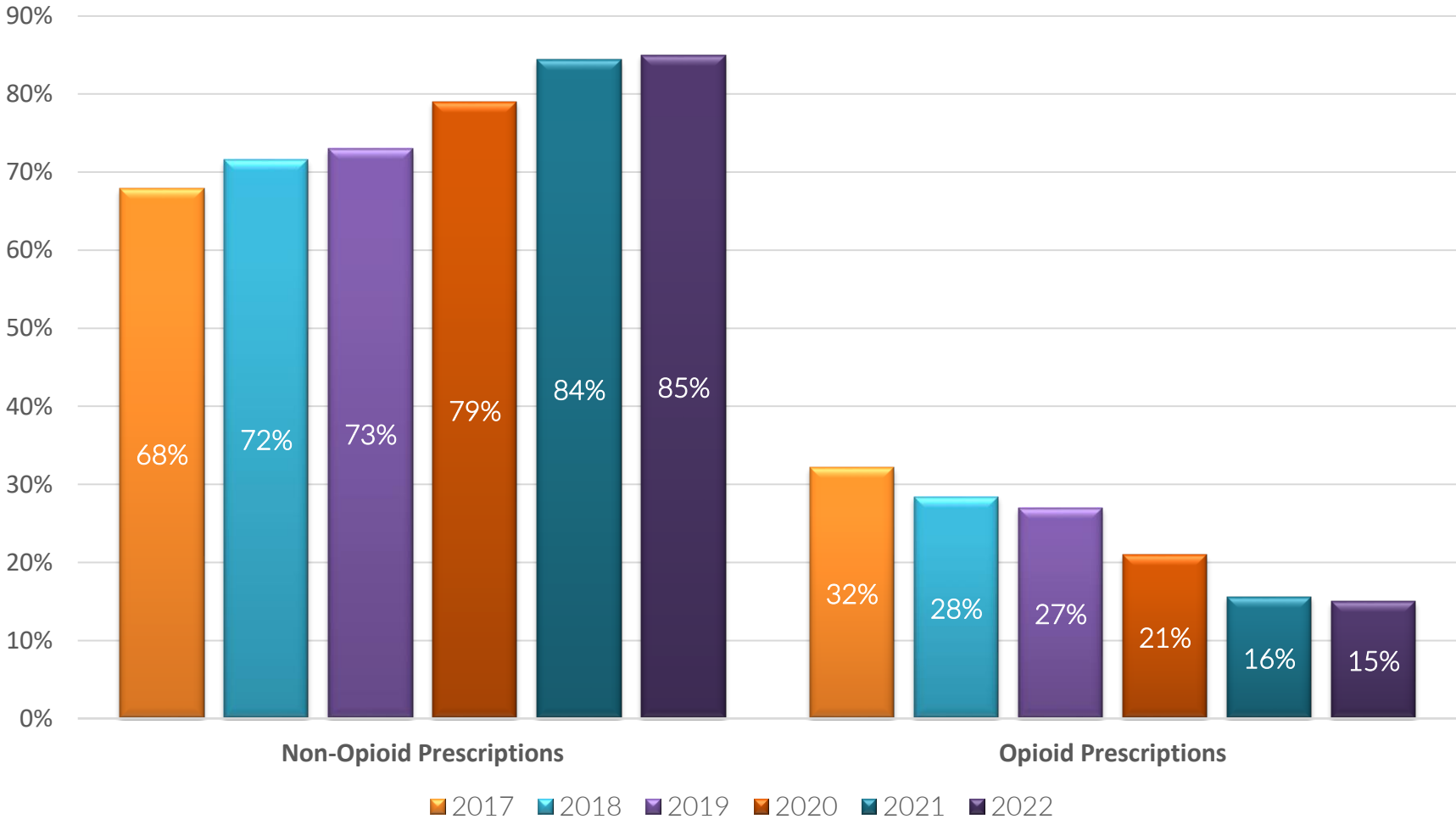
2022 % Prescriptions > 90 MME vs. All



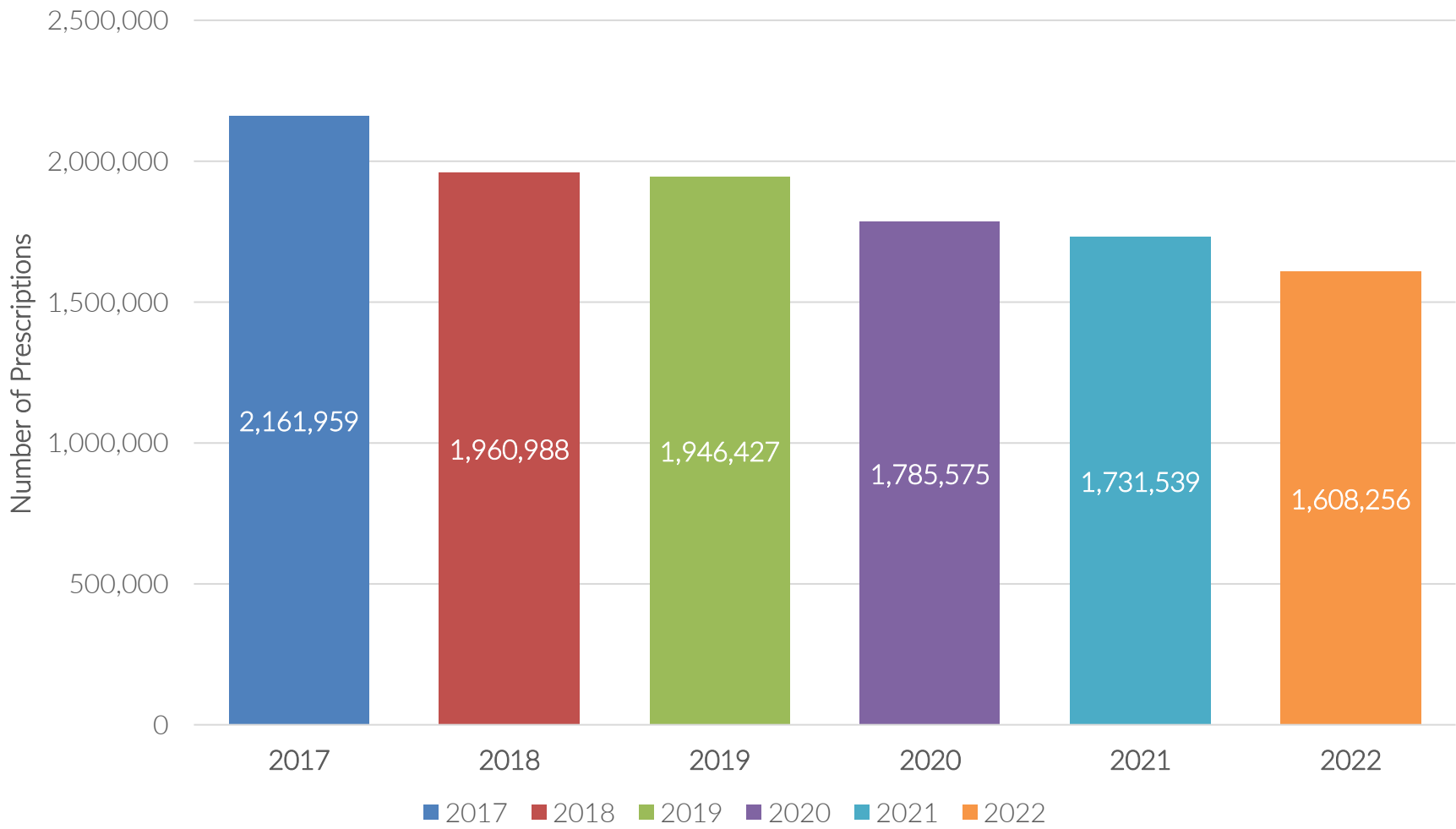

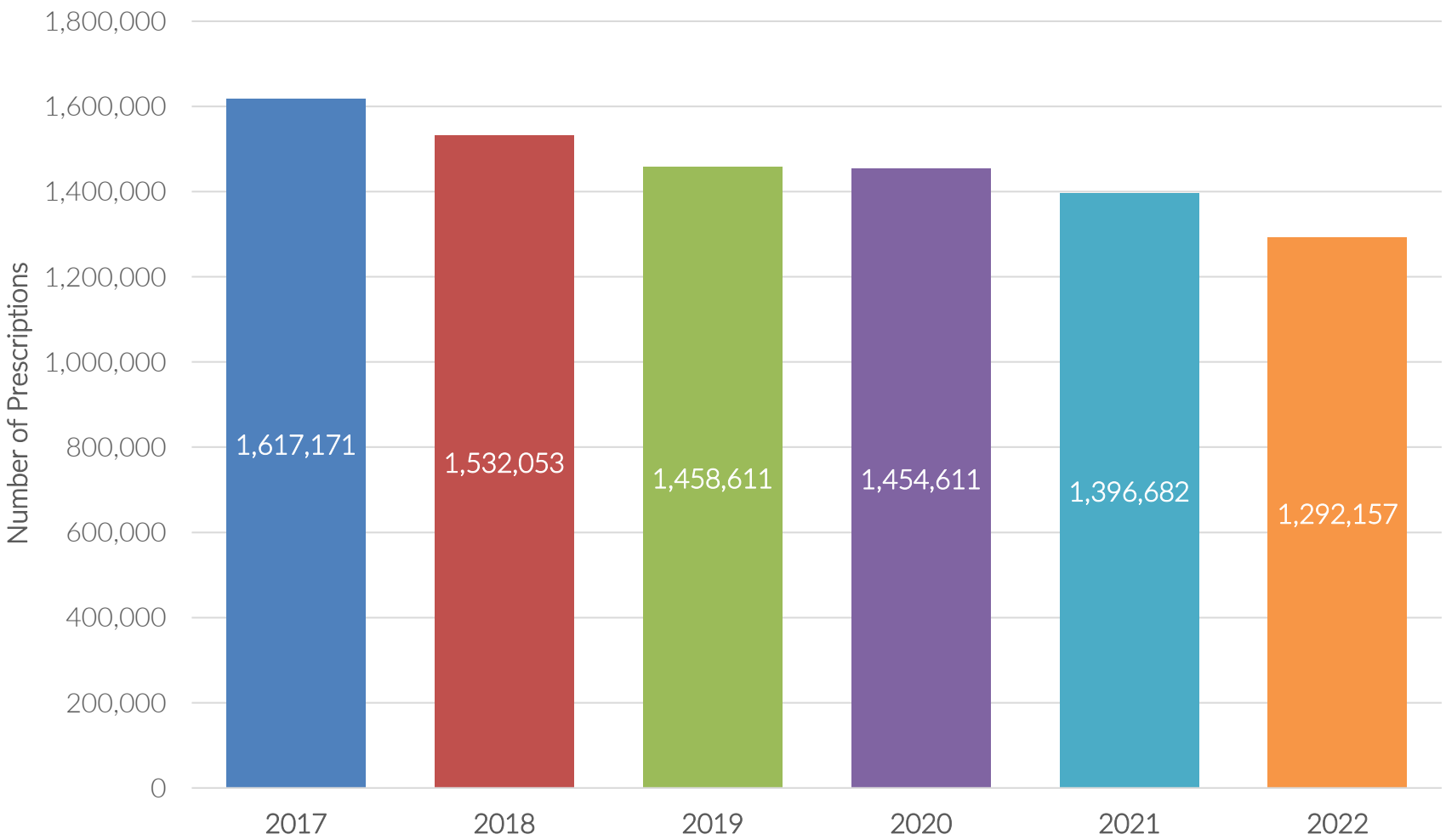
Opioid vs. Non-Opioid Prescriptions



Opioid Prescriptions per Year

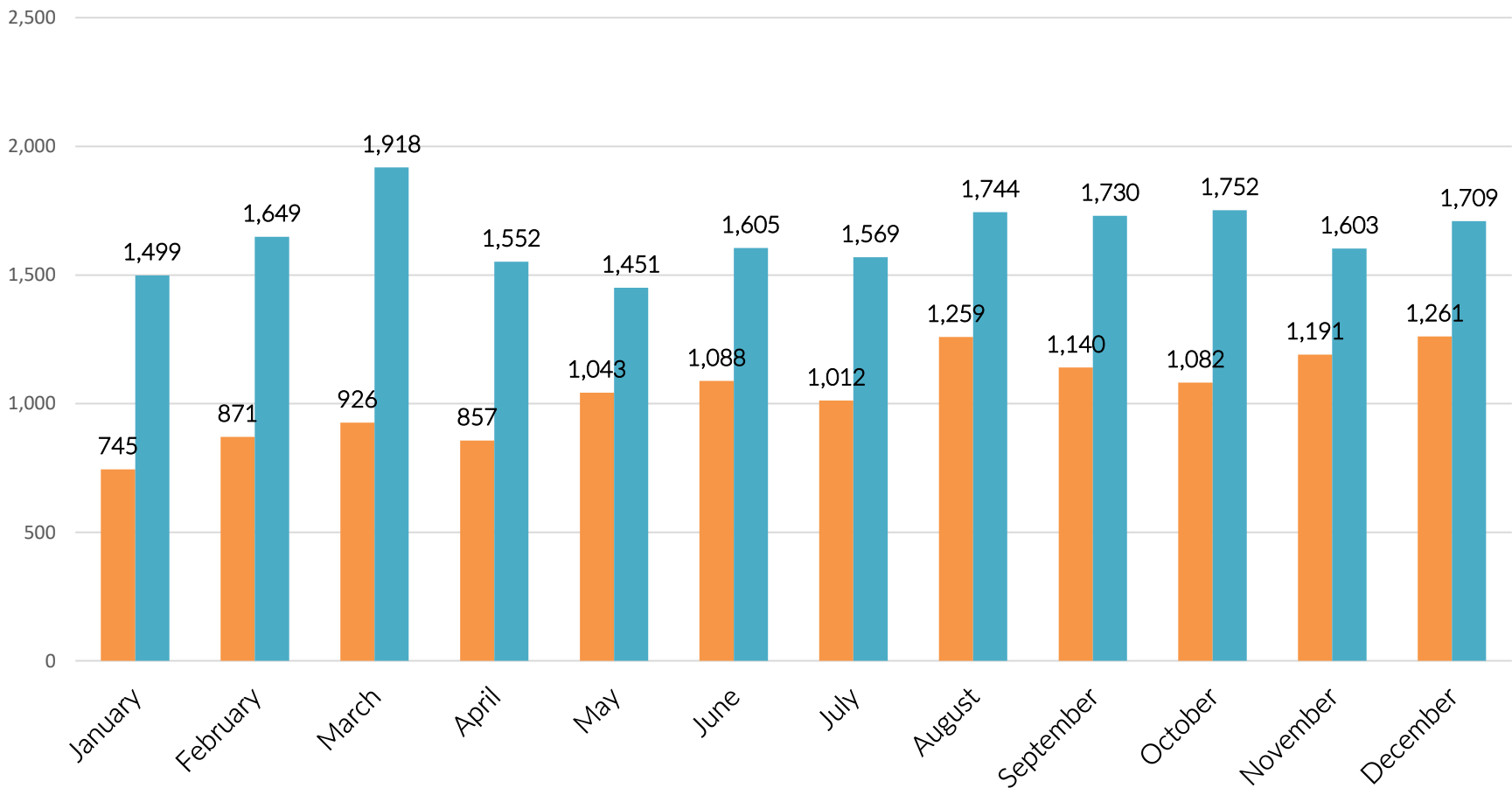


Benzodiazepine Prescriptions per Year



Naloxone Dispensed per Month

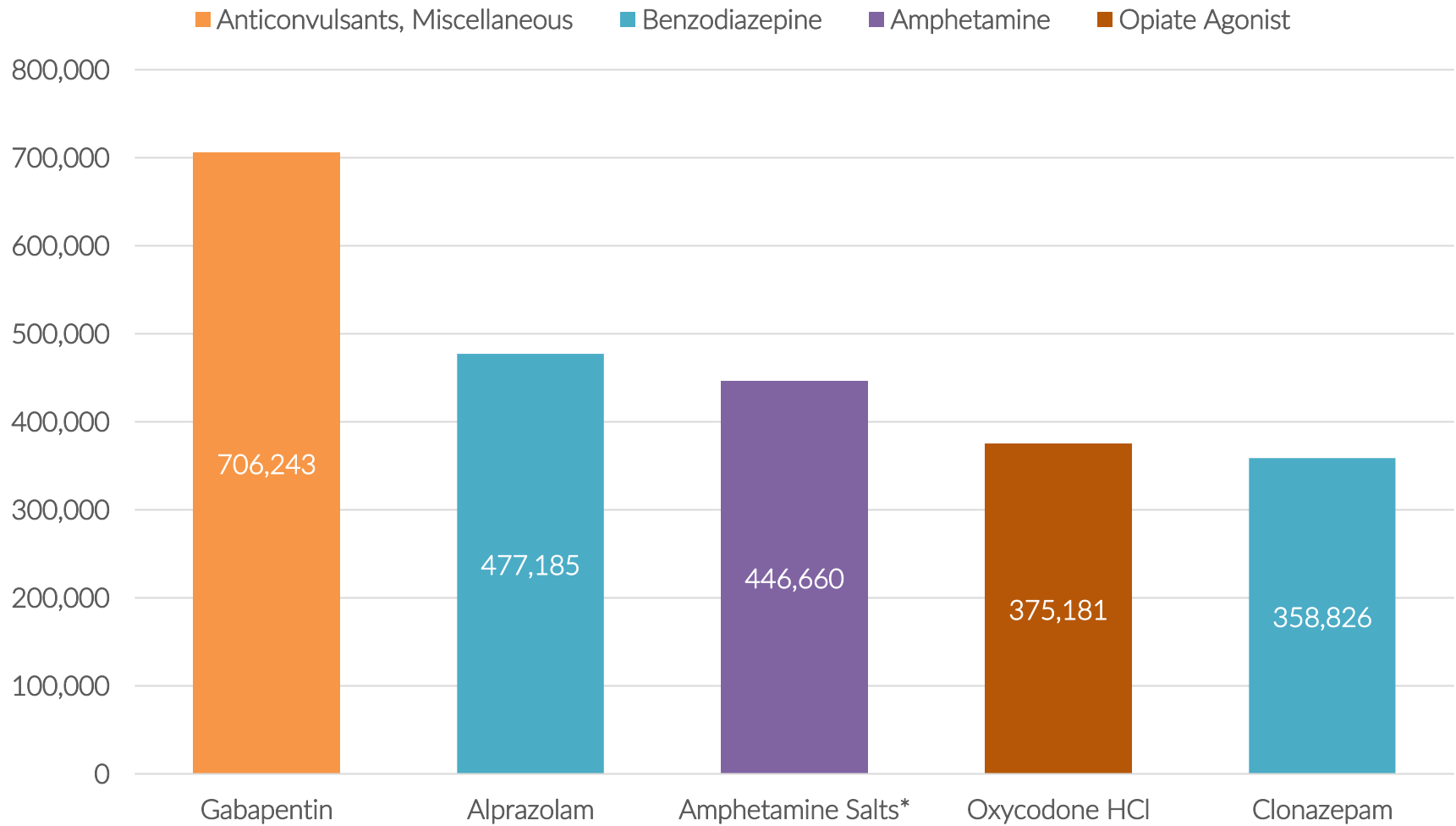

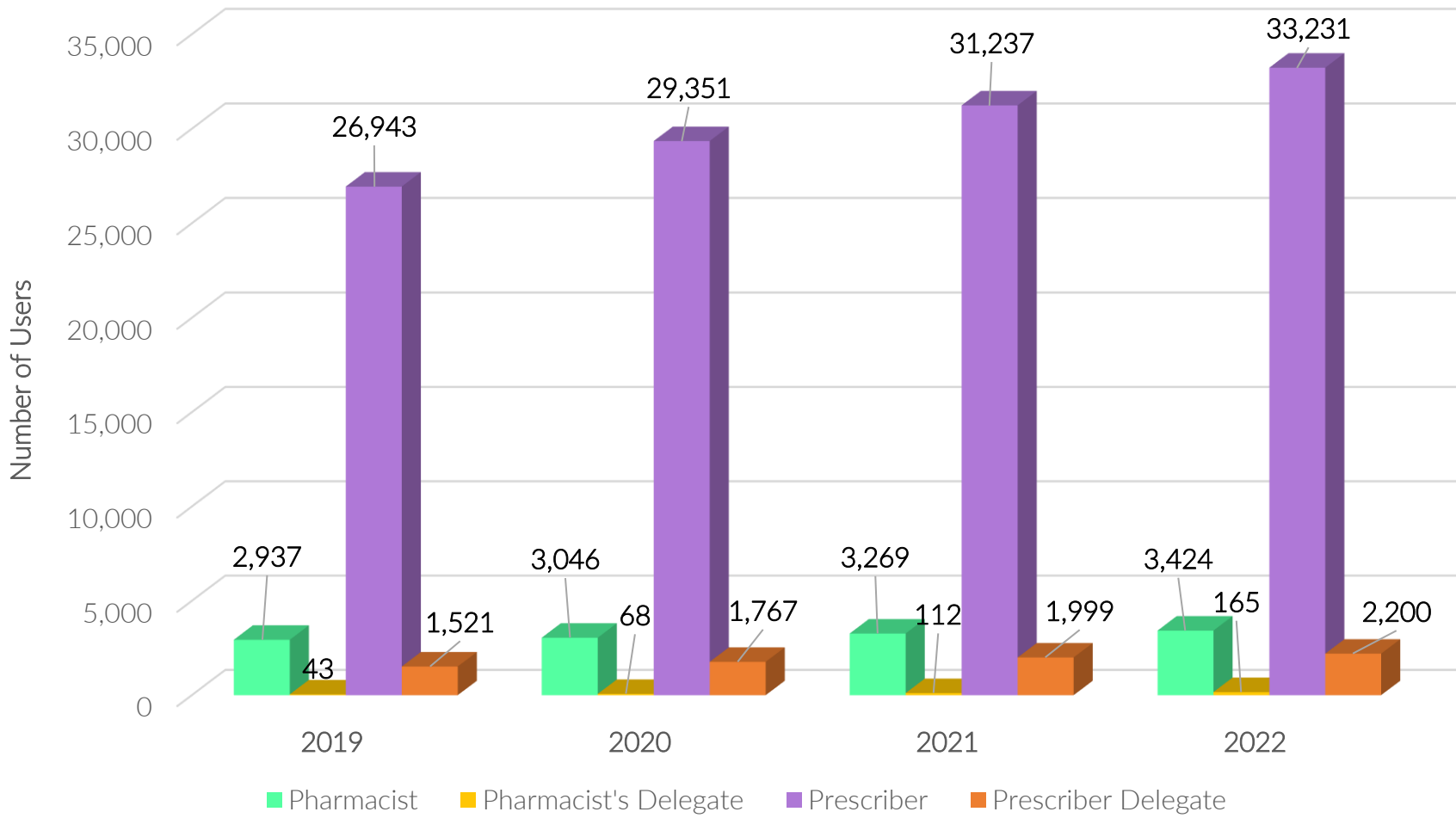




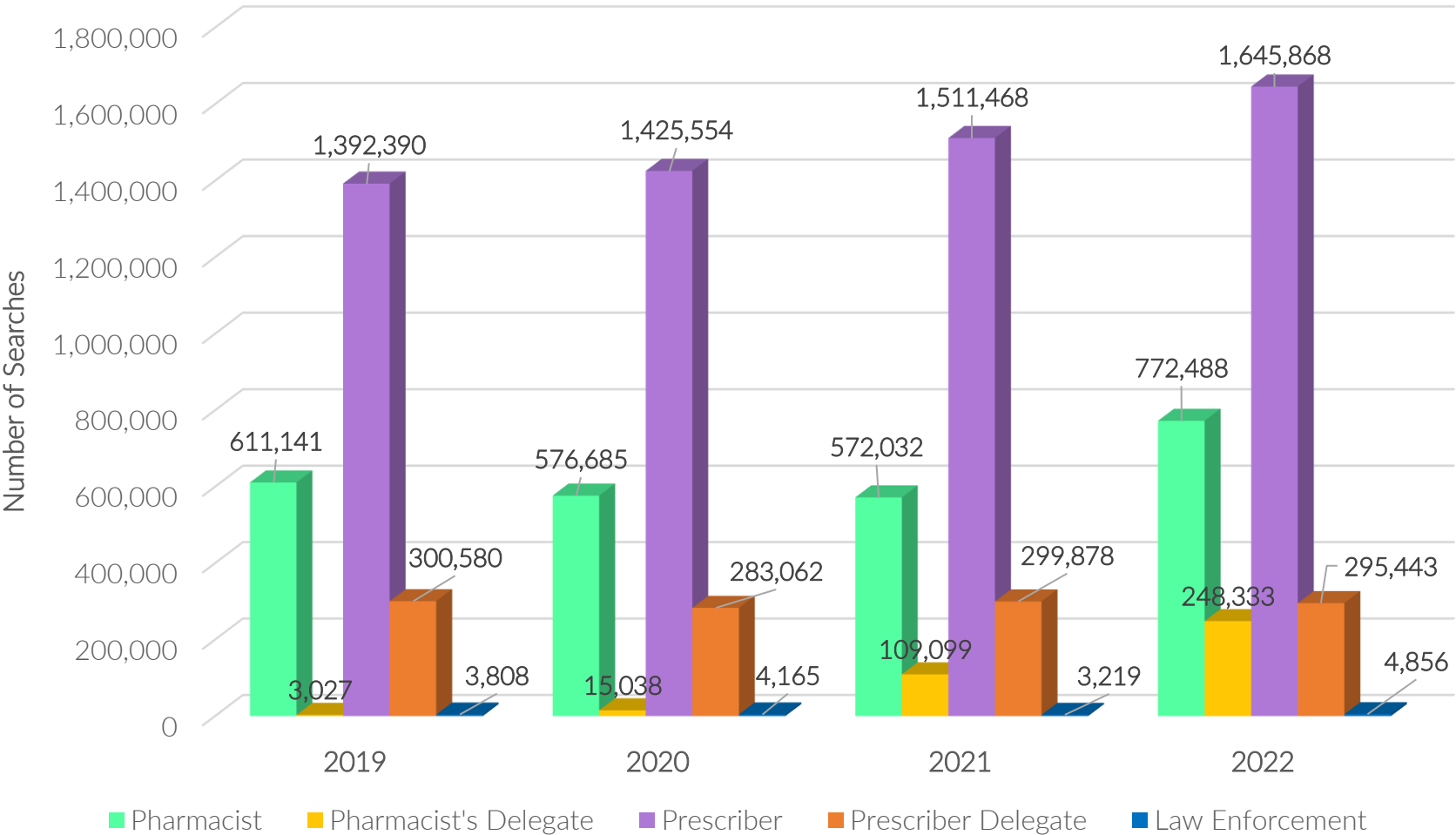

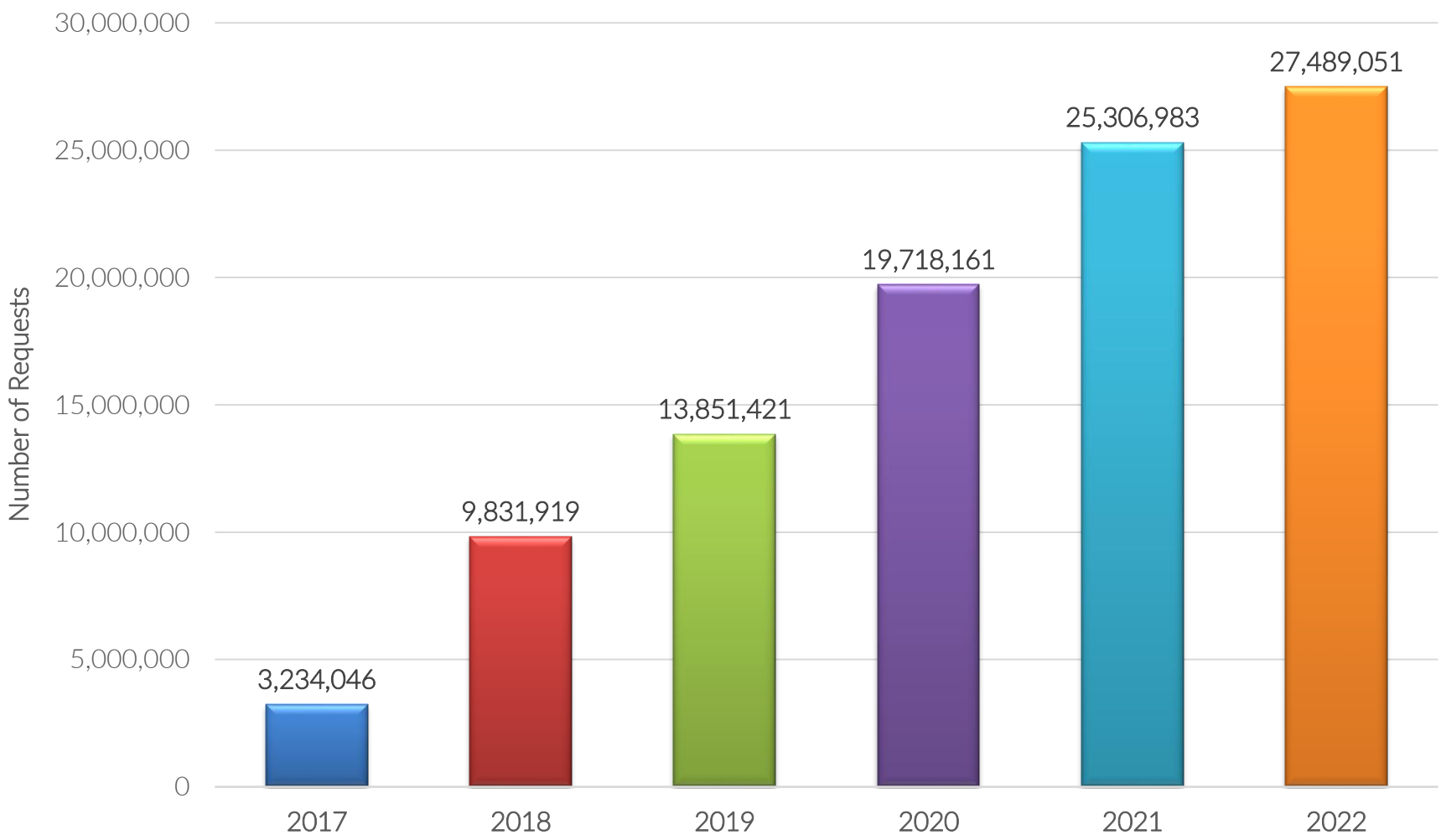
Users Registered in the CPMRS per Year



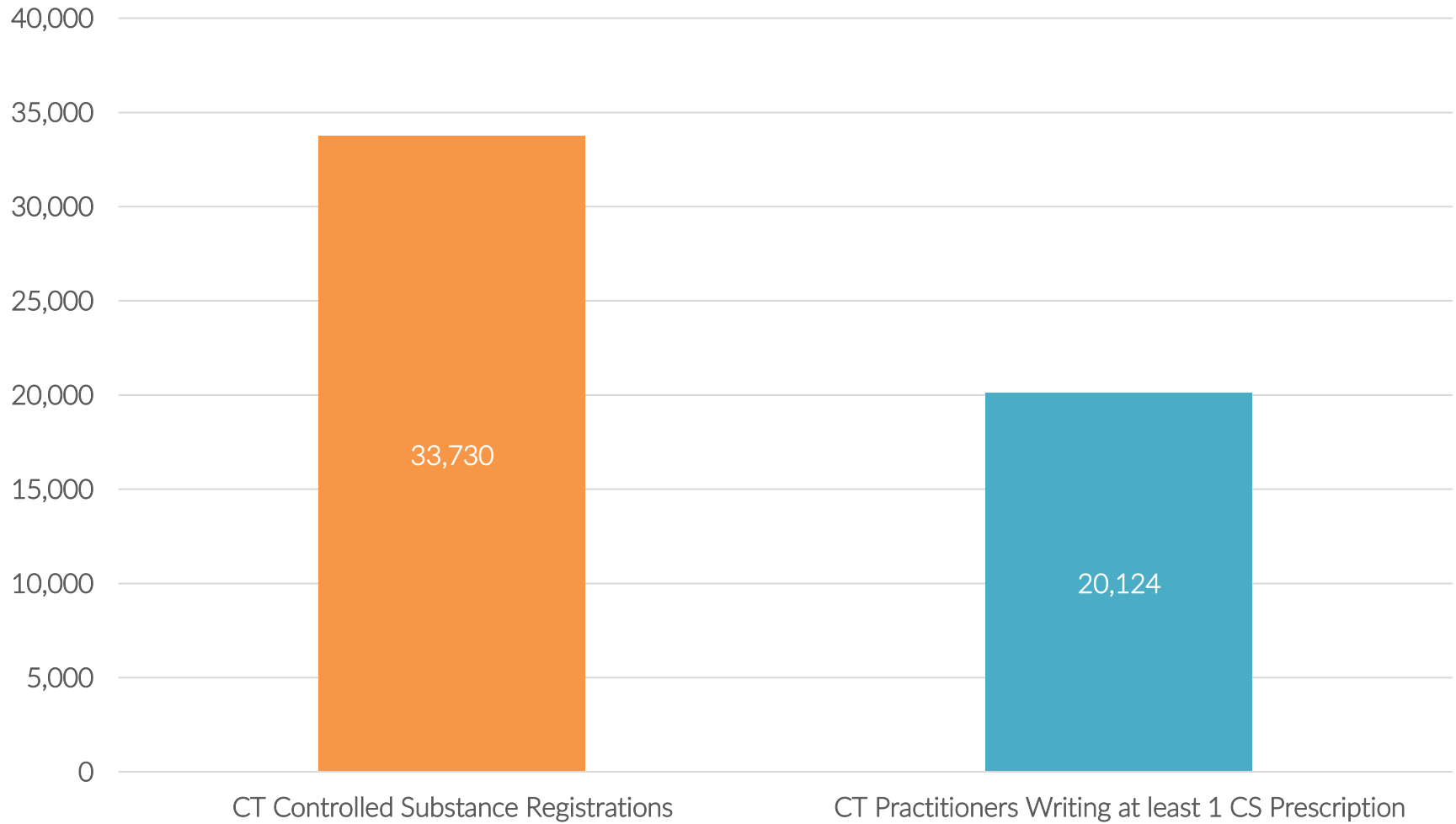
CPMRS User Searches per Year



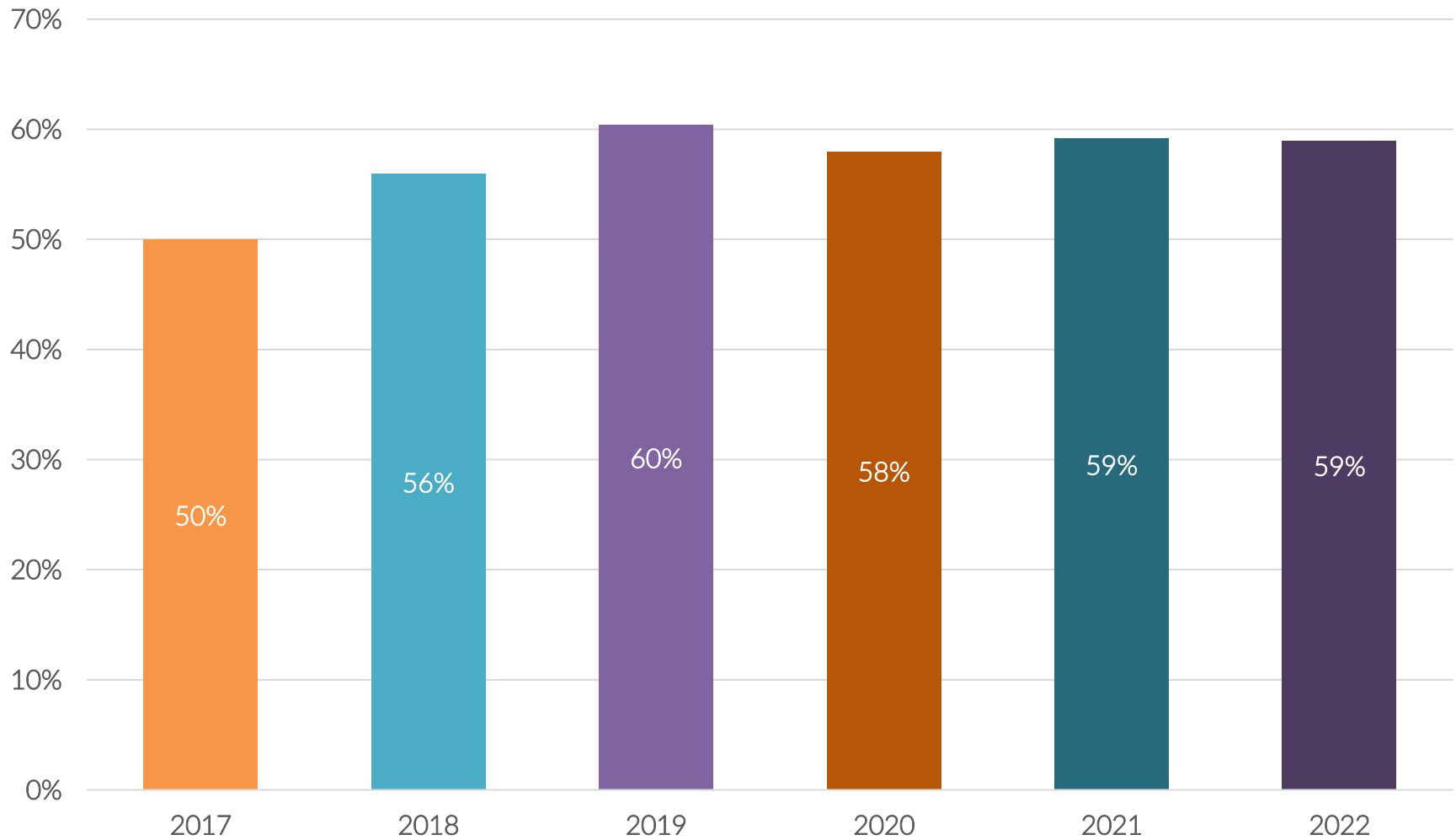
Gateway Requests per Year
