RE: Extension of Credit Terms for February 13, 2024

The Department received a written request from Brescome Barton seeking approval to extend customer credit for accounts with credit terms closing on Monday, February 12, 2024 until February 14th due to the winter storm scheduled to hit Connecticut throughout the day on February 13th. Pursuant to this request, customers could still receive orders on Wednesday, February 14th even if the customer had an invoice coming thirty-days due on Tuesday, February 13th.

The Department has reviewed this request and is cognizant of: (1) The widespread forecasted impact of the February 13th winter storm and its likely impact on normal retail and wholesale operations; and (2) the popular Valentine's Day holiday on February 14th. The Department approves Brescome Barton's request to extend customer credit one extra day from February 13th to February 14th and provide deliveries on February 14th to such customers. The Department extends this approval to all wholesalers.
