On March 30, 2017, after due notice, the Department of Consumer Protection, Liquor Control Commission, held a formal administrative hearing on a question of Sec. 30-20(c) of the Connecticut General Statutes, to determine whether the premises meets the definition of "grocery store." The record was left open to allow for a change in the proposed permittee and for the filing of a new breakdown of sales.
