On May 4, 2017 after due notice, the Department of Consumer Protection, Liquor Control Commission, held a formal administrative hearing on the charge of a violation of Section 30-22a(a) of the Connecticut General Statutes, in that you failed to renew your annual food license with the Uncas Health District. Despite proper notice, the respondent did not appear at the January 7, 2016, formal administrative hearing.


Based upon the testimony presented at the hearing, the Department of Consumer Protection finds you to be in violation and, in accordance with Sec. 30-6-A8(c) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, **ORDERS** your café liquor permit **suspended immediately** until such time as receipt of written notice that the food license has been renewed.




