4D. DCP Investigation Division Complaint Status Report; review of complaint report including open, closed, and dismissed cases for review.

Mr. John Neumon addressed the Board and gave then a procedural overview on the Department's complaint reporting procedures to the various Boards and Commissions. It was noted that there are currently no active complaints involving this Board. The report's format was discussed and noted by the Board that the format is what they have been asking for quite some time. Their concern is to keep abreast of complaints and to be sure that they are being acted upon and not fallen out of sight so to speak.

4E. Any correspondence and/or business received in the interim.

1. Ms. Paulette Annon introduced herself to the Board. Ms. Annon is a newly hired Staff Attorney and has been assigned to this Board. Ms. Annon gave them an overview of her professional and educational background. Ms. Annon will be primarily involved with enforcement and will be responsible for bringing any complaints before the Board in the future. The Board introduced themselves, welcomed her, and looks forward to working with her in the future.

5. Comments or Concerns of any Person Present Today.

1. Mr. Neumon noted that he was contacted by a representative of the Glazier Board regarding the requirements for the use of glass in furniture on the inside of buildings. The Department will be meeting with them on June 23, 2017 for further discussion. He also noted that the Glazier Board was concerned that there might be some architects may not be aware of the requirement for work that necessitates a glazier's license.

Ms. Harp Jones cited a related matter involving a professional member of AIA/CT and the potential need for glaziers to perform work on a project in Hartford he was involved with. The project had high visibility and involved outside funding due to the historic nature of the restoration. As it turned out, glazier work was not required on this project as determined by law. Ms. Jones noted that the project was slowed significantly because of the need to address the glaziers concerns.

2. The Board discussed their attendance at the upcoming NCARB Annual Business Meeting in Boston, Massachusetts. Mr. Hurd noted he will be in attendance for the complete event. Ms. Holland will not be able to attend. Ms. Cahill will attend Thursday

and Friday. Mr. Barkin will attend beginning Wednesday afternoon through Saturday morning.

Mr. Hurd noted that there, at present, there are no issues/challenges regarding elections to the NCARB Board positions. Further, there are no resolutions to be acted upon this year. Voting should be uneventful. Mr. Hurd noted the Regional Executive Board decided to invite past Board Members including former Board Chair Ed Jeter to the regional meeting and dinner that evening in recognition of their service on the Boards.

3. The Board voted to have Mr. Barkin continue as their Acting Chairman until their next meeting. (Cahill/Holland) As an aside, Mr. Barkin would like to pursue filling this Board's vacancy and getting an appointment of a permanent Chair after the legislative session concludes

The meeting adjourned at 9:45AM. (Barkin/Holland) The next regular meeting of the Architectural Licensing Board is scheduled for Friday, August 18, 2017 at 9:00 AM; 450 Columbus Boulevard, North Building, Hearing Room J, Hartford, Connecticut 06103.
