1. Review of minutes of the May 17, 2019 Architectural Licensing Board Meeting

3. DCP Investigation Division Complaint Status Report

3A. Board to review report when provided

The Board reviewed two complaint reports dated 03/01/19 to 04/29/19 and 04/30/19 to 6/30/19.

3B. Discussion regarding format of complaint report

Discussion took place with Pamela Brown and Julianne Avallone regarding the Board's concerns about the format and content of complaint reports. The Board noted that the two complaint reports submitted today reflect that there are no complaints at this time. Pamela Brown stated that there are no complaints pending in the Investigations Division at this time however there are ten cases currently in the Legal Division. The Board requested that, going forward, they receive a report including the status of all complaints, including those that are assigned to both the Investigations Division and the Legal Division, and the date each case was opened. Pamela and Julianne will meet subsequent to today's meeting to discuss how to best utilize DCP's e-license system to provide the Board with the information requested.

4A. NCARB 2019 Annual Business Meeting

4B. Application of Ryan Haley

Angela Cahill stepped down to review Ryan Haley's credentials and provided an analysis for the Board. After discussion, the Board voted to approve Mr. Haley to sit for the examination in Connecticut. (Cerrone, Barkin) (Twig Holland opposed)

5. New Business

5A. Review of proposed Architect Licensure Regulations

Julianne Avallone provided an overview of the regulation review process and discussion took place regarding the proposed regulations. It was determined that,

although the Board is in favor of the proposed regulations as they are written at this time, Board members will postpone voting on them until language is developed to add to the regulations in order to address specific aspects of continuing education being proposed, such as audit procedures, penalties, and deadlines to be applied.

This item has been tabled until the September 27, 2019 meeting, at which updated proposed language will be presented for further discussion.

5B. 2020 additions to the Architect Statutes; under 20-294 add language to place conditions on a license in the event of an enforcement action and establish fines, penalties and late fees for failure to meet minimum C.E. requirements.


