CEO Mike Armstrong introduced, Vice President of Council Relations, Josh Batkin along with Jessica Carmona, who also works with council relations.

Mr. Armstrong stated that NCARB's last visit to Connecticut was about six years ago and wanted to update the Board to any changes during that time. The one issue that many Boards face is the lack of staff and funding regarding investigations of complaints. NCARB is doing a study to determine if there is some kind of service to help boards address this issue.

Mr. Armstrong advised the Board that they met with the Department's staff, Howard Osden and Barbara Syp-Maziarz to understand the current staffing, mechanics and protocols that exist. There were some minor issues that NCARB will address and work with the department's staff to resolve them.
