RECONSIDERATION OF PREVIOUSLY SUBMITTED APPLICATIONS

Michael J. Primicerio, North Branford, CT – (D-2) Limited Journeyman Application.

The Board denied Mr. Primicerio's application at their 6/22/06 meeting due to lack of required occupational related experience.
