6. Camp Harkness Fund:

A. Monthly Report

i. Presentation

- A presentation is being developed with slide show and flyers for the Camp Harkness Fund website
- Vicki received help from with a laptop and pointer for the website from a young lady in New London
- The hope is to get some "hot spot" type of system for next summer

ii. Wellness Workshops

- Workshops start March 5, 2016 with a Naturopathic Workshop day-long event
- \$35 includes lunch
- Nutrition classes will follow 3 classes at \$5 each
- Fund will subsidize classes
- Meditation workshop will also be offered

iii. Summer Fest

Date will be Saturday, July 30, 2016

iv. Spring Clean up

- Clean up in May was late last year
- Suggested that this year's clean up might be on Earth Day, Friday May 22, 2016
- Another possibility would be on the Day of Caring, Saturday May 23, 2016 however, Passover starts that weekend, so no Saturday before April 16th would be a good time

v. Fencing

• Donation for fencing from Bill T. in the amount of \$500 is a good start but work will have to be done to raise the additional funds needed

vi. Uncommitted Funds

- Uncommitted funds amount to \$9000
- some will be used for camperships
- wheelchair accessible picnic tables are needed current tables are too high
- MaryAnn will research "Pilot Rock" a company on file which may be a source of equipment; she will get quotes

7. Old Business:

A. Camp Report

i. Camp Usage/ Events

- October 2015: 2360 people, 260 cabins, 2095 attended special events, etc; Pfizer Cleanup
- November 2015: 1400 people, 150 cabins, 1295 attended special events; Motorcycle Gift Run
- December 2015: 255 people, 135 cabins, The Arc New London County Winter Camp; other special events; gift run gifts and gift cards were distributed, 295 individuals and families benefited
- Reservations: working on 1st round with hundreds of calls; will wait until April for people to get second reservation; many want August 15th when camps end and kids are on vacation
- Accessible tools for Gardeners: Joan wants to donate them; Vicki will decide if the donated tools are appropriate and if not, perhaps they may be obtained from Camp Harkness Fund
- Camp has two donated electric beds

ii. Physical Plant

- Frank reported that Ernie's crew worked on signs
 - Signs will be on Azek plastic paint first then router
 - o Most will be painted hunter green use color of cabin groups
 - o Bleach and water to clean
 - o 16 signs for \$100 (vs. quote of \$9000)
 - o 4x4 post on each side with sleeve and cap painted gray
 - Ouestioned used of solar cap as well
 - o Bey asked if they were available in braille at correct height and code
 - Stan responded that the signs were more for drivers
- Brown cabins mirrors were hung in half bath, towel racks are up
- Funds are available for Dining Hall exterior work
- Bathroom doors will be replaced with single wide doors, possibly automatic once has to be done in spring
- Barn area and beach areas are okay
- Question regarding picnic tables to be made in Azek vs. pine material old picnic tables were great per Bev; Vicki will check catalogues

B. Website Update

- Waiting for conformation from Carin
- Front page applications and updates to DDS Camp Harkness website
- MaryAnn concerned about people not knowing to look at DDS for Camp Harkness
- Work is being done to add links from Camp Harkness Fund website if "Camp Harkness" is searched on Google you get "Harkness State Park", then "DDS Camp Harkness" with two (2) clicks you are at the website

C. Seniors Volunteer Program

- Will be like Mystic Seaport Pilot Program
- Betsie will call Seaport Memberships to learn more

D. Camp Pass Application

- Question as to whether current application is okay or if Autism should be listed
- Carin has feedback on this and will share when she attends next meeting
- Nancy has some issues with applicants' answers should they be signed by a doctor or is it okay for them to be stamped
- Nancy may refine and get the process to come to Harkness Park
- Check with Carin Mancini and have secretary and maintenance department work on-site rather than at Uncas

E. Bingham Beach

- The Beach is now a part of Waterford Park
- Questions were raised regarding security, people walking through, parking problem
- Dan said that their beach fills up
- There is a need to educate gate staff to ask for pass holders and turn away non-pass holders
- If visitors can show proof of disability they could come in and fill out a pass application
- Questions were raised regarding what reasonable things could be done to reduce the flow
- Staff training; add more security staff
- Camp Harkness staff would work on gate and stop traffic
- Jackson said requests for additional summer staff would have to be made now
