As you begin your transformational planning through STEP, we wanted to emphasize the importance of **involving individuals, their support teams, and DDS case managers**. STEP is focused on person-centered transitions that allow individuals to flourish in supports that meet their goals and the best fit for their needs. To match individuals effectively, collaboration is critical. Here are some things to keep in mind as you plan for transitions:

- Work with individuals early and often to understand their transition goals. Transitions won't be a fit for
 everyone, and individuals should be enthusiastic and willing participants.
- Coordinate with families and support teams to gather support and to identify transition roadblocks, risks, and challenges.
- Collaborate with case managers to identify strategies to mitigate these transition challenges and lean on IP sessions for STEP conversations.

The STEP team also held trainings and info sessions for DDS staff, including case managers. They are extremely excited about STEP and these transformational efforts and need to be part of the process. As you develop plans, make sure you are also engaging with the planning and support teams, which includes the case managers and individuals to ensure everyone is engaged in the process early on.
