

# Overview of Specialized Services

- Specialized Services implemented effective February 1, 2019
- Provides Community based day and behavioral services to individuals with ID who are long term placed in Skilled Nursing Facilities
- Not a DDS Waiver Service
- Specialized Services is a Medicaid State plan amendment (SPA 19-0009)
- DSS program that is direct bill to Medicaid.
- Medicaid benefit for individuals who meet the criteria: ID, Active Medicaid, Long-term Placement in a SNF.

# **Service Definitions**

## Group and Individualized Day Services

- Day services shall only be provided by an enrolled provider in a community-based program. This service is limited to no more than 6 hours per day. Additional hours may be approved via the prior authorization process based on individual needs.
- Group and individual day services are delivered by a community-based provider of day habilitation in a setting other than the resident's nursing facility
- Group day services include transportation between the facility and the site where group day services are provided. Group day includes DSO; GSE; Senior Supports
- Individual day services are delivered as outlined in the individual's plan of care and includes transportation.
- Provider review (IPR) every six months to report progress on goals outlined in the IP.

# **Service Definitions**

### **Habilitative Behavioral Support and Consultation**

- Includes initial assessments and monthly follow along.
- Assessing and evaluating individuals' clinical needs.
- Developing a behavioral support plan that includes intervention techniques as well as teaching strategies for increasing new adaptive positive behaviors and decreasing challenging behaviors in the individual's environment.
- Training and teaching family members and support providers
- Work in conjunction with behavioral health supports in the facility
- Quarterly reviews of plan data and effectiveness

# **Referral Process**

- Individual must be determined eligible for Long-term care by DDS nurse Ascend Level
   II.
- Planning can begin with the regional DDS CM if the team feels that a long-term placement is going to recommended.
- LTC DDS CM will work with provider to assist in establishing services.
- PRAT request is not needed.
- Case Manager will work with Resource Management to have a CSA sent prior to the start of services.

# Facility-Based Day Services


- Currently not approved under Specialized Services
- DDS recognizes need and benefit for day services for individuals who may not be able to leave the SNF during the day.
- Continued advocacy to DSS to include facility-based day programs.


### Differences between short-term day services and long-term day services.

• Individuals who are in SNF for Short-term rehab (90-180 days) – CAN receive facility based IDN through DDS funding. Provider should work with Resource Management to adjust the CSA. This is meant to be temporary until the individual is discharged or determined to meet criteria for Long-term care.

# Provider Enrollment and Billing

- DDS Providers can enroll as a Medicaid Provider for Specialized Services via Gainwell Technologies
- Enrollment and Billing Presentation <a href="https://www.ctdssmap.com/ctportal">https://www.ctdssmap.com/ctportal</a>
- CSA from DDS with hours of approval (no funding amount)
- Bill DXC every 2 weeks
- Common Billing issues: Individual's Medicaid has lapsed; incorrect Medicaid #; clerical errors within DDS system
- Confirmation from Gainwell once enrollment is complete.
- Re-enroll every three years














# **Current Nursing Home Guidelines**

- SNFs are overseen and licensed by DPH
- Subject to current/future DPH guidance regarding COVID
- SNF Cannot prevent a resident from accessing Specialized Services in the community
- Risk Assessment DDS provider plan is acceptable
- Staff testing (monthly) or proof of vaccination (discuss directly with facility)

# **Starting Services**

- Team Meeting prior to starting services
- Individual/Family/Guardian
- Specialized Service Provider
- DDS LTC CM
- Nursing home representative –social worker, nurse, etc.

# Tips for teaming with Skilled Nursing Facilities

- On-going communication with facility
- Contact person social worker; head nurse, etc.
- Concerns DDS CM; Regional LTC Ombudsperson
- Participation in IP Process/Care planning
