The Center for Human Development (CHD) has been a provider of community-based behavioral health and social services since its inception in 1972. Our mission is to provide a broad range of high-quality, community-oriented human services dedicated to promoting, enhancing and protecting the dignity and welfare of people in need. Our vision is two-fold: We envision that vulnerable populations will be integrated in to and supported by their community of choice: and that CHD will provide support by operating autonomous community-based programs that are innovative, efficient and effective. We realize our mission and vision, by pursuing six strategic goals, including: 1) provide clinical services with exceptional outcomes; 2) be the employer of choice for CHD's diverse workforce; 3) create a data-driven culture and build upon our technological capacities; 4) communicate CHD's values, priorities, and mission to internal and external stakeholders; 5) explore, develop, and implement dynamic and effective models of care; 6) enhance our continuum of services through partnerships, mergers and other innovative opportunities.

We fulfill our mission, vision, and strategic goals by providing more than 70 programs and services across the lifespan that support those experiencing mental health challenges, homelessness, substance use, abuse and neglect, aging and illness; those with developmental and intellectual disabilities; and those in the juvenile justice and foster care systems. Our core expertise is in providing residential, outpatient, and outreach case management and therapeutic services for these vulnerable populations. Each year, our community-based social service and behavioral health programs reach over 25,000 people in Western Massachusetts and Connecticut. We currently employ nearly 1,600 professionals across all locations. Working in local communities, and partnering with local agencies, we provide services that promote real and lasting change. CHD is accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF), which sets high standards for the quality of care.
