Our mission is to provide each individual with the best possible quality of life through residential and community-based opportunities. Our strong compassionate culture demands that all decisions be made with the individuals' involvement and in their best interests. This is ensured through an innovative person-centered approach that delivers services based on the specific interests, abilities, and changing needs of each person.

CBS is committed to increasing the number of individuals employed in fully integrated settings. CBS recognizes the needs for a customized vocational plan for every person seeking employment. To this end we provide Prevocational and Supported Employment services to provide supports in job readiness training. People seeking employment opportunities receive comprehensive training in pre-employment skills, supports in workplace behavior and assessment of job skills.

Respite services are available for people and their families on an hourly basis. Respite provides an opportunity to caregivers to take some needed time off from caring for a family member with a disability. Respite provides peace of mind in knowing that a loved one is being cared for by an experienced professional while the family member attends to his or her own appointments or takes a well-deserved break.

In an effort to support people in the pursuit of their dreams, CBS offers opportunities for a blended program of day services. Our staff are currently assisting local school districts in transitioning graduating students to available programs upon graduation from high school.
