I provide the following services: (1) behavioral evaluations including functional analysis; (2) designing and monitoring behavioral interventions; (3) in-service training of both a general nature about behavioral analysis and behavioral programming on behalf of individuals with developmental disabilities as well as of a specific nature when teaching others the details of a behavioral intervention for a consumer with whom they are involved; (4) designing appropriate evaluation plans for assessing and monitoring the impact of interventions; (5) reviewing behavioral data resulting from either a baseline or intervention for making clinical decisions about possible next steps; (6) providing clinical and programmatic consultation to direct care staff, professionals and families; (7) conducting in-service parent and family training; and (8) providing individual behavioral counseling services on behalf of individuals with developmental disabilities and their families.
