Provider Description

Information provided by the provider describing their agency:

The Caring Community currently operates twenty community living arrangements, commonly known as group homes. The agency also operates two CRS homes. Each is a well-appointed, typical middle class residence, located in urban or suburban neighborhoods. All consumers receive 24-hour guidance and assistance. Our agency also provides a supervised living arrangement for 1 individual who resides in his own apartment with staff available to provide guidance and supervision on an as needed basis (IHS).

Fotheringhay Farms provides agri-based pre-vocational skill development in green house, barnyard and garden settings. It provides an environment where individuals can expend energies, employ both gross and fine motor skills and develop nurturing capacities in growing plants and vegetables or caring for animals.

Maintenance work crews provide individuals who, due to serious behavioral problems, cannot seek employment in the community with real work experience in a controlled setting. The individuals in this program accomplish minor repairs and maintenance for the group homes and earn commensurate wages.

Day Support Option (DSO) allows individuals with physical and or medical conditions to occupy their days with productive and fulfilling pursuits based in the community. Arts and crafts, cooking, volunteer work (delivering meal-on-wheels), beneficial exercise, and recreational activities are the focus of these programs.

Senior Support Program is geared to those individuals who no longer have the physical stamina to participate in DSO activities.
