Drop	\$2.00 first 1/8th mile
Travel Rate	\$0.25 each 1/8th mile
Waiting Time	\$0.25 each 36 seconds

Also the optional statewide fuel surcharge.

In the town of Fairfield:

Drop	\$2.50 first 2/10th mile
Travel Rate	\$0.20 each 1/10th mile
Waiting Time	\$0.20 each 30 seconds

Also the optional statewide fuel surcharge.

In the city of Norwalk:

Drop	\$2.75 first 1/9th mile
Travel Rate	\$0.25 each 1/9th mile
Waiting Time	\$0.25 each 34 seconds

No fuel surcharge participation.

**PROPOSED RATE**

Drop	\$2.40 first 1/8th mile
Travel Rate	\$0.30 each 1/8th mile
Waiting Time	\$0.30 for 31 seconds

With the statewide fuel surcharge only reviewed April 1 and October 1 (Every company must elect to participate in the fuel surcharge program in total or not at all. All of a company's authorized vehicles will participate or none will participate. Also the participation must be to the fullest that exists at the time.)

Pursuant to Section 4-177a of the Connecticut General Statutes, any person may request party status, if such person has submitted a written petition to the agency and mailed copies to all parties, at least five (5) days before the date of the hearing and the petition states facts that demonstrate that the petitioner's legal rights, duties or privileges shall be specifically affected by the agency's decision in the contested case.

In addition, any person may request intervenor status if such person has submitted a written petition to the agency and mailed copies to all parties, at least five (5) days before the date of the hearing and the petition states facts that demonstrate that the petitioner's participation is in the interests of justice and will not impair the orderly conduct of the proceedings.

All petitions for party or intervenor status must be submitted in written form and received by this department no later than five (5) days prior to the date of hearing. Otherwise, such requested status shall be subject to denial. The five-day requirement may be waived at any time before or after the commencement of the hearing on a showing of GOOD CAUSE. Copies of any requests for party or intervenor status must be mailed to the applicant and to all known parties.

An original and **FOUR (4) COPIES** of all prepared documents and exhibits intended to be introduced as evidence in this matter by the applicant, party, or intervenor must be filed with the department no less than **SEVEN (7) DAYS** prior to the date of hearing. All filings must be mailed to:


