The records of the Department of Transportation ("Department") indicate you are the holder of Certificate No. 1394. The records of the Department further indicate that you are in violation of Connecticut General Statutes Section 13b-410 by violating the terms of the certificate which requires the certificate holder to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other statutes and/or Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies:

Allegations and Charges:

- a.) Connecticut General Statutes Section 13b-410 Violation of the terms of certificate which requires the certificate holder to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other statutes and/or rules, regulations and orders of the Department.
- b.) Section 16-304-D1 Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies failure to file proof of insurance as required.

More specifically, it is alleged that on or about December 31, 2014 the certificate holder failed to provide a current Form E, evidence of insurance, with the annual Intrastate Permit Application for Household Goods Carriers Operating under Authority of the Connecticut Department Transportation in violation of Connecticut General Statutes Section 13b-410c(b).

Therefore, pursuant to Connecticut General Statute Section 13b-407 as amended, you are hereby directed to appear at the office of the Department of Transportation, 2800 Berlin Turnpike, Newington, Connecticut 06131, Conference Room A to show cause why Certificate No. 1394 should not be revoked, suspended and/or a civil penalty imposed for failure to comply with the applicable provisions of the General Statutes stated above.
