The records of the Department of Transportation ("Department") indicate you are the holder of Permit No. 2839. The records of the Department further indicate that you are in violation of the following Connecticut General Statute Section (CGS) and/or Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies (RCSA) Connecticut General Statute Sections 13b-102, 13b-103, 13b-106 as amended, by violating the terms of the permit which requires the permit holder to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other statutes, and/or rules, regulations and orders of the Department.

More specifically:

1) On May 29, 2015 it came to the Department of Transportation's attention that there are no vehicles registered under this permit authority. This initiated a headquarters check for Aristocrat Limousine, Inc. The headquarters check confirmed that the company is no longer there. Our inspector spoke to Mike at that location and he said the company had closed its doors a long time ago. This is a direct violation of the RCSA Section 16-325-1, which provides that permit holder must have a headquarters where the permit holder or his employee is in attendance.

Therefore, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 13b-103, as amended, you are hereby directed to appear at the Newington office of the Department of Transportation, 2800 Berlin Turnpike, Newington, Connecticut, Conference Room A on Thursday, September 3, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. for a citation hearing to show cause why this permit should not be revoked or suspended or a civil penalty imposed for failure to comply with the applicable provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes and/or the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies as stated above.
