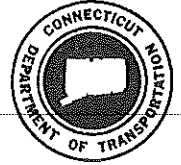

The records of the department indicate you are the holder of Permit No. 3159. The records of the department further indicate that you are in violation your livery permit issued in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes (CGS) Section 13b-103 by violating the terms of said permit which require the permit holder to comply with all relevant statutes and regulations governing livery service,

More specifically:

The records of the department show that First Classic Limousine, LLC is in violation of the following:

Violation of Connecticut General Statutes CGS Sections 13b-102(b) for failing to maintain registration with the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration;

Violation of Connecticut General Statutes CGS Section 14-29 for failing to maintain insurance;

Violation of Connecticut General Statute CGS Section 13b-103 for operating livery service without a permit (SCS Transportation);

Violation of Connecticut General Statute CGS Section 13b-106 for failing to register vehicles under its permit;

Therefore, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 13b-103, as amended, you are hereby directed to appear at the Newington office of the Department of Transportation, 2800 Berlin Turnpike, Newington, Connecticut, Conference Room A on Tuesday, October 20, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. for a citation hearing to show cause why this permit should not be revoked or suspended or a civil penalty imposed for failure to comply with the applicable provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes and/or the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies as stated above.
