The records of the department indicate you are the holder of Permit No. 3505. The records of the department further indicate that you are in violation of the following Connecticut General Statutes (CGS) and/or Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies:

CGS Sections 13b-102 and 13b-103, as amended, by violating the terms of the permit which require the permit holder to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other statutes, and/or rules, regulations and orders of the department.

More specifically, on or about November 16, 2017, it came to the attention of the department that Wright Transportation, Inc. had moved the location of its headquarters in Uncasville located at 152B Route 163, to a point outside of the municipality specified in its permit, to North Franklin in violation of Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-325-4.

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statute Section 4-182, as amended, you are hereby directed to appear at the office of the Department of Transportation Administrative Law Unit, 2800 Berlin Turnpike, Newington, Connecticut 06131, on January 4, 2018 at 11:00 AM, Hearing Room A, for a show cause hearing as to why this permit should not be revoked, suspended and/or the imposition of a civil penalty for failure to comply with the applicable provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes and Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, as stated above.
