The records of the Department indicate you are the holder of CT Livery Permit Number 125. The records of the Department further indicate that you are allegedly in violation of the following Connecticut General Statutes (CGS) and of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies:

• CGS Section 13b-103, as amended, by violating the terms of the Permit, which require the Permit holder to comply with all pertinent laws and other statutes.

More specifically, on or around March 22, 2019, Mr. Matthew B. Lund of Stanwich Congregational Church submitted a complaint, given DOT Case No. LV-03-2619-18, bringing to the Department's attention that Nason Partners, LLC, DBA Kelley Transit Company is allegedly unsuitable to operate its Certificate. Mr. Lund claims that Nason Partners, LLC, DBA Kelley Transit Company entered a contract to provide motor bus transportation service, and received and deposited a payment while simultaneously in the process of closing the business and ceasing its operations.

In addition, the Department performed an investigation, and discovered that Nason Partners, LLC, DBA Kelley Transit Company is allegedly in violation of the following:

- Connecticut General Statutes:
- o Sec 13b-103 Suitability of the management (Collected fares and discontinued service).
- o Sec 13b-106 Registration (Failure to maintain motor vehicles registered).

Last, an internet search reveals that the company is listed as permanently closed.

As a result, you are subject to a hearing pursuant to CGS 13b-102, and 103. In addition, you are subject to a penalty pursuant to CGS 13b-108.

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statute Section 4-182, as amended, you are hereby directed to appear at the office of the Department of Transportation Administrative Law Unit, 2800 Berlin Turnpike, Newington, Connecticut 06111, on July 25, 2019, Hearing Room A, at 1:00 pm for a Show Cause hearing

as to why this Permit should not be revoked, suspended and/or the imposition of a civil penalty for failure to comply with the applicable provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes and Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, as stated above.
